The Assam government has given its in-principle nod to the initiation of the process for Socio-Economic Assessment of the five indigenous Muslim communities ---Goria, Moria, Deshi, Syed and Jolha. The chief minister said that on its completion, the data can be utilized by the Assam government to take steps for comprehensive socio-political, academic and economic uplift of the five indigenous Muslim communities. The State Cabinet has already approved the indigenous status for these five communities.
