Chief Minister Neiphiu Rio and NITI Aayog Vice Chairman Suman Kumar Bery today inaugurated the Integrated Business Hub and Innovation Centre at Dimapur. Speaking at the event, Rio said, to truly unlock Nagaland's potential, we must embrace innovation, entrepreneurship, and investment. It is with this vision that the Integrated Business Hub was conceptualized and brought to life, he said, adding that the hub will facilitate and support investors, startups, and entrepreneurs alike. The Chief Minister said, at the heart of this initiative lies a commitment to streamline administrative procedures, promote transparency, and provide quick support to investors through a single-point coordination strategy. He noted that priority will be given to startups, entrepreneurs, and investors who are eager to invest in Nagaland, while collaborations with local talent to seize untapped opportunities will be encouraged. He said opportunities will be created for retail, food courts, corporate offices, marketing fronts for PSUs and innovative enterprises, among others. Dedicated support team, comprising representatives from IDAN and other government departments, will ensure seamless transition to permanent locations for investors, and also provide essential support services, including legal assistance, information on local business practices, and access to vital resources. During the programme, Rio also launched Intellectual Property Facilitation Centre, Capacity Building Training for NGOs by CII, Innovation and Startup Training for Entrepreneurs, Startups Podcast initiative, Swavalamban Connect Kendras, Dimapur, Entrepreneurs Networking Station, and Education & Skill Loan Facilitation Centre.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi today launched the 'Pradhan Mantri Samajik Utthan and Rozgar Adharit Jankalyan' (PM-SURAJ) national portal and approved credit assistance for one lakh entrepreneurs from disadvantaged communities. He also interacted with beneficiaries of various government schemes benefiting marginalised groups through video conference. Modi also distributed Ayushman health cards and PPE kits to sewer and septic tank workers under the National Action for Mechanised Sanitation Ecosystem (NAMASTE).

Joining the rest of the country, Nagaland today launched the PM-SURAJ portal, a credit outreach programme to the disadvantage sections of the society. Addressing the event, Advisor CAWD and Taxes, Kudecho Khamo said the portal is specially for sanitation workers and commended those who are risking their lives to keep the towns and cities clean. He highlighted the government's belief that a nation can progress only if the last person is inclusively taken care of in the journey to development. He therefore asked leaders, bureaucrats and all people concerned to ensure that all opportunities and schemes reach and benefit the intended people. On the occasion, Ayushman Health Cards and PPE kits under NAMASTE were distributed to sanitation workers of Kohima and Dimapur.

Raksha Mantri Rajnath Singh has approved a proposal for the expansion of the National Cadet Corps (NCC) with the addition of three lakh cadet vacancies. The expansion plan encompasses the establishment of four new Group Headquarters and addition of two new NCC units. It also proposes for employing ex-servicemen as NCC instructors. The NCC will now have a sanctioned strength of 20 lakh cadets in its roles making it the largest uniformed youth organisation of the world. The far-reaching impact of this expansion will lead to proportionate distribution of vacancies across all States and Union Territories and reduce the waiting list of institutions aspiring for the NCC.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has expressed confidence that India is set to become a global hub in semiconductor manufacturing in the coming times and a leader in Industry 4.0. He said this today after laying the foundation stone of three semiconductor projects worth over 1.25 lakh crore through video conferencing. The projects include India's first commercial semiconductor fab at Gujarat, and one Outsourced Semiconductor Assembly and Test facility each in Assam's Morigaon and at Sanand in Gujarat. The Prime Minister said the northeastern states are becoming stronger to connect with the South East Asian countries and no one ever thought before of setting up such an industry in this region. Modi said chip manufacturing will open limitless possibilities for the youths of our country and take India towards Self-reliance and Modernity.
