India and Bhutan yesterday exchanged several agreements of mutual interest to further strengthen their partnership. The documents were exchanged between India and Bhutan in the presence of Prime Minister Narendra Modi and Prime Minister of Bhutan Tshering Tobgay in Thimphu. Meanwhile, Prime Minister Modi will inaugurate the Gyaltsuen Jetsun Pema Mother and Child Hospital in Thimphu today. The state-of-the-art hospital has been built with the assistance of India in Thimphu.



Governor of Nagaland, La. Ganesan has urged the young graduates to embrace an adventure that promises to enrich challenges, perspectives and broaden the horizons with new cultures, ideas and opportunities to transform. Speaking at the 6th convocation ceremony of Nagaland University, Lumami yesterday, Governor Ganesan also advised the students to acquire maximum knowledge and earn a place among the best in the world. The Central Board of Secondary Education (CBSE) has disaffiliated 20 schools for engaging in malpractices. The Board has disaffiliated Five schools from Delhi alone. A notification by the CBSE said the stringent action was taken after discrepancies were found in adherence to affiliation and examination norms during surprise inspections by the board. CBSE also said that these schools were committing various malpractices of presenting dummy students, ineligible candidates and were not maintaining records properly. After a thorough inquiry, the board decided to disaffiliate and downgrade them.

Nagaland Taekwondo team has emerged as the champions of the Taekwondo event held as part of the Northeast Games 2024 at Sovima Futsal ground. Nagaland team won 12 medals - 4 gold, 5 silver, 3 bronze. It was followed by Manipur in second with 4 gold, 1 silver, and 3 bronze of the overall medal tally. Mizoram state is in 3rd position with 3 gold, 4 silver, and 2 bronze of the table tally. This is the first time, Nagaland have dominated the taekwondo event over the past three edition held for the North East Games. The two-day-long championship started on Thursday with participation from seven states. Meanwhile, Manipur surged ahead in the medal tally winning 32 Gold, 22 Silver, and 24 Bronze medals, totalling to 78 medals. Nagaland team slipped to second securing 31 Gold, 22 Silver, and 28 Bronze medals, totalling 81 in medal tally and Assam make its presence with 29 Gold, 33 Silver, and 32 Bronze medals. boasting impressive total of 94 an medals.
