Nagaland got its first Histopathology Unit at Naga Hospital Authority Kohima, NHAK yesterday. Vice Chairman of NITI Aayog Suman Kumar Bery officially inaugurated the laboratory by unveiling of Plaque. The "State of Art" Histopathology Laboratory, funded by Numaligarh Refinery Ltd under the Corporate Social Responsibility, CSR, will play a pivotal role in early cancer detection. Numaligarh Refinery Limited has contributed over 1.28 crore rupees for procuring histopathology equipment. In addition, Doctors For You will fund approximately 40 lakhs and support the training of manpower and provide additional resources when needed. Speaking at the programme, Vice Chairman of NITI Aayog Suman Kumar Bery said, CSR initiatives with involvement of various agencies is making huge differences and impacting the society and the environment. Bery also emphasised in mobilising CSR resources and also maintain its creditability. Managing Director NHAK, Dr Sendimeren Aonok termed it a historic moment for the state. He said, the histopathology unit being the first in the state is the need of the hour in addressing the rise of cancer in the state.
