Union Finance Minister Nirmala Sitharaman yesterday reiterated the government's commitment and resolve to bring the North-Eastern states at par with the rest of country on development index and provide equal opportunity as in other parts of the country. Addressing the Viksit Bharat Ambassador Campus Dialogue at IIT Guwahati, the Finance Minister listed out a series of developmental programmes initiated and launched under the Narendra Modi-led government during the last ten years and how it has brought a paradigm shift in the development of the North-Eastern region. She informed that more than 25,000 crore rupees development funds have been allocated for the North Eastern states so far while 6,600 crore rupees funds were given for job-oriented development in the region.
