The Election Commission has initiated several innovative and unique campaigns on social media platforms to engage young and urban voters for enhanced participation in the upcoming elections. The poll body through campaigns like 'Turning18' and 'You are the One' is employing tailored messaging strategy incorporating compelling themes, collaboration with popular ECI icons and GenZ content. The primary objective of ECI's 'Turning 18' campaign is to galvanize youngsters to participate in the upcoming elections and address the critical issues of urban and youth apathy noticed in previous elections. On the other hand, 'You are the One' campaign aims to recognize and celebrate the invaluable contributions of various stakeholders involved in the electoral process. The Election Commission has also started a special campaign to curtail fake-news and misinformation on election processes.

National Council of Educational Research and Training (NCERT) have issued an advisory warning against copyright infringement of its educational materials. It said that any individual or entity who publishes the content of NCERT textbooks for commercial use without obtaining copyright permission shall be subject to legal proceedings under the Copyright Act. The educational body further urged the public to refrain from using such textbooks or workbooks, cautioning that their content may be factually incorrect.
