The Jawaharlal Nehru University emerged as the highest-ranked Indian university in the World University Rankings list released yesterday by London-based higher education analytics firm, Quacquarelli Symonds (QS). Under the subject of Development Studies, JNU was ranked 20th. The university was also the country's top-ranked university in the subjects of Geography, History, Modern Languages, Politics & International Relations, Anthropology, English Language & Literature, and Linguistics. Further, the Indian Institute of Management (IIM) Ahmedabad is among the top 25 institutions around the globe for business and management studies while IIM-Bangalore and Calcutta are in the top 50. A total of 69 Indian universities made it to the rankings with 424 entries across all subjects.

The Centre has directed all States and Union Territories, UTs, to enforce weekly stock disclosure of pulses by all stockholding entities and verify the stocks declared by them. The Consumer Affairs Ministry said, stocks in warehouses located in major ports and in pulses industry hubs should be verified from time to time. It has also asked them to take strict action on stockholding entities found to be reporting false information on the stock disclosure portal. Apart from the five major pulses, namely, Tur, Urad, Chana, Masur and Moong, the States and UTs have been asked to monitor the stock position for imported Yellow Peas.
