Chumoukedima Deputy Commissioner Abhinav Shivam said that the extortion cases in Chumoukedima are not as rampant as in Dimapur and as such the reaction of the business communities should also reflect the situation of the district. The DC was speaking during a meeting yesterday with regard to closure of business establishment under Chumoukedima district. He acknowledged the proactive role of the CSOs, youth organisation and the Police in addressing illegal taxation. He briefed the members on the letter of the Home Department and said that the Government has taken cognizance of the illegal taxation case and issued appropriate orders and urged the business communities to end the closure of business establishments with immediate effect. Shivam also suggested that the district administration, police and CSOs can coordinate to formulate a system of a task force or a cell to address the situation and to take action promptly. He also suggested regular meeting of all the stakeholders. In the interest of public welfare, the meeting also attended by Chumoukedima Chamber of Commerce & Trade Association and CSOs agreed that business establishments under the district will open by tomorrow.
