In a remarkable accomplishment, young mountaineer Kabak Yano from Kabak village in Kamle district summited Mount Everest today around 11.50 am. This was informed by Everester Tagit Sorang. She is the 5th woman from Arunachal and first woman from the Nyishi community to scale the world's highest peak at 8848.86 metre above sea level. A student at Rashtriya Raksha University, Pasighat campus, 25-year-old Yano completed Basic Mountaineering Course from Himalayan Mountaineering Institute (HMI), Darjeeling, and Advanced Mountaineering Course, and Search & Rescue Course from National Institute of Mountaineering and Adventure Sports (NIMAS), Dirang. She has also been a part of the state women's cricket team.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi today fired fresh salvos at the INDIA bloc in Bihar at a poll rally and tore into Congress-RJD governments for "forced" migration of youth from the state. Prime Minister accused the Congress and its allies of ruining 60 years of the country and also destroying the lives of three to four generations and said that they will be made to pay the price for such 'injustice' by the citizens. He said that the 21st century cannot move forward with the 'sins' of the INDIA bloc and asserted that people of the country will 'strike back' at the "ill-intentions" and "misdeeds" of Congress and RJD on June 4, the day when results for Lok Sabha elections will be declared. Taking a swipe at Congress and its "prince", PM Modi said that the Opposition doesn't have any agenda in the elections, other than "abusing" him.

Anti-Terrorism Day was observed across the nation today. The day marks the death anniversary of former Prime Minister Rajiv Gandhi, who was assassinated on May 21, 1991 by a suicide bomber of the Liberation Tigers of Tamil Eelam (LTTE) at Sriperumbudur, a village near Chennai. It is observed to educate the people about the negative impact of terrorism and violence on society and the nation. Meanwhile, Prime Minister Narendra Modi paid tributes to former PM Rajiv Gandhi on his death anniversary. Congress president Mallikarjun Kharge, Congress Parliamentary Party leader Sonia Gandhi and former Congress president Rahul Gandhi paid floral tributes to Rajiv Gandhi at Veer Bhumi in New Delhi.

Tirap district Deputy Commissioner Ira Singhal has emphasized the importance of preserving the unique cultural heritage of Borduria while developing its tourism potential. "Our goal is to create a sustainable tourism model that benefits the local community and preserves the rich cultural and natural heritage of Borduria circle," said the DC while on a visit to the Borduria circle on Monday to evaluate the region's tourism potential. The meeting, chaired by Commissioner (AHV & DD) Bidol Tayeng, noted that though the "increasing number of dog bite cases was a matter of concern for all, but all the bite cases were not that of rabid dogs rather most of the bites were of pet and domesticated dogs." While different means were discussed to control the population of stray dogs in the capital, the proposal for catching and confining stray dogs by authority or NGOs and sterilizing them was accepted as the most standard procedure, officials said.

West Siang Deputy Commissioner Hage Mamu, accompanied by District Planning Officer Marjum Karga, has on Monday inspected some of the major ongoing centrally sponsored projects in the district. The inspected projects include multipurpose community hall, construction of multi-storey building for parking at Aalo, walkway in riverfront, and the viaduct construction work near Takpu Bagra at 309.781 Km of Potin-Pangin section of NH-13. While expressing satisfaction over the way the projects are being executed, the DC advised the site engineers of the company and the field officers of the highway department to ensure quality of work and complete the projects on time.
