State Election Commission Nagaland has appealed Eastern Nagaland People's Organization (ENPO) for participation in ULB election. Drawing attention concerning ENPO's abstention from participating in the Nagaland ULB elections the Commission said, it is cognizant of the stated context of the issue surrounding the ENPO's stand. The Commission viewed that the method adopted to express their stand on collective abstention from participating in the ULB election needs a reasoned reconsideration. The Commission said, the constitution of Urban Local Bodies like the Municipal and Town Councils in Nagaland through the participation of the local community in the electoral process

is an essential requirement for incorporating the common aspirations and grievances of the local populace. The Commission said, it is committed to holding free and fair elections to all the Municipal and Town Councils in the State. Therefore, the Commission has requested the ENPO to reconsider its stance of asking citizens to abstain from participating in the ongoing ULB elections. The State Election Commission further said, it will ensure that all polling processes will continue as per the election scheduled.

Chairperson of Nagaland Board of School Education Asano Sekhose said, the focus of learning process today should aim at making the students learn the fundamentals or basics, have conceptual clarity and develop critical and analytical thinking skills. She was addressing the 50 years celebration of Chandmari Higher Secondary School, Kohima today. Sekhose underscored that education imparted to students should be to learn with understanding and the knowledge they get, become practical and applicable to accomplish their goals. She maintained that education is to develop the innate abilities of an individual while it is a continuous process of growth, and pointed that NEP 2020 envisions a transformational shift in education system. Observing that the world is witnessing rapid changes in every field, along with various confronting challenges, she asked the social institution to channelize efforts to educate, train students to face the challenges that are ahead. In this regard she also asserted the need to create conducive environment that cultivates genuine thirst for knowledge and encouraged students to explore their passions naturally. Sekhose also urged the school to strive for excellence, embrace innovation and continue nurturing young minds with compassion and care. Earlier a monolith to commemorate the

occasion was unveiled by Rev. Dr. Meyu Changkiri, Pastor, Ao Baptist Church Shillong.

Senior BJP leader Rajnath Singh said, prominent economists and financial firms worldwide have acknowledged the initiatives launched by Modi government that have helped in lifting 25 crore people out of poverty over the past 10 years. He was speaking at a political rally in favor of a party candidate in Basti district of Uttar Pradesh today. Speaking at the press conference, NCP (SP) Chief Sharad Pawar said that BJP is floating false narratives like associating the INDI alliance with Pakistan to divert people's attention from relevant issues like unemployment. Meanwhile, addressing media persons at the conference, Shiv Sena

(UBT) chief Uddhav Thackeray attacked the NDA and said they are defaming and cheating the state of Maharashtra.
