The Government has identified around 6.8 lakh mobile connections as fake and invalid. These connections are suspected to have been obtained using invalid, non-existent, fake Proof of Identity and KYC documents. The Department of Telecommunications has directed the Telecommunications Service Providers to carry out immediate reverification of these identified mobile numbers. The Service Providers are mandated to re-verify the flagged connections within 60 days. The department added that failure to complete re-verification will result in the disconnection of the concerned mobile numbers.



The Secretary for Information and Broadcasting Sanjay Jaju yesterday said that the national centre of excellence to train the youth on animation and visual effects is on the anvil.
