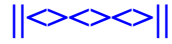

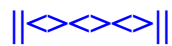


The landfall process of severe Cyclonic storm Remal was completed between 10.30PM and 12.30AM in the intervening night of yesterday and today. This was revealed by Habibur Rahman Biswas, Head of the Alipore Area Cyclone Warning Centre. The system would continue to move nearly northwards for some more time and then north-northeastwards and weaken gradually into a Cyclonic storm by today morning. The forward part of severe cyclonic storm Remal had entered the land between the Sagar Islands of West Bengal and Khepupara in Bangladesh with the wind speed of about 110 to 120 Kilometres per hour at around 8.30PM last night. All the districts of South Bengal, including Kolkata witnessed storm and heavy rains under the influence of the cyclone. Many roads in Kolkata were waterlogged and several trees were uprooted. Meanwhile, Prime Minister Narendra Modi chaired a meeting in New Delhi on Sunday to review the preparedness for cyclone “Remal” over North Bay of Bengal.

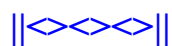


Amid rising heatwave, the Ministry of Health, has advised employers to take essential heat safety measures at the workplace. Exposure to extreme heat can affect health, ranging from rashes to serious and potentially fatal health problems such as heat exhaustion and Headache, feeling dizzy, dehydration, and breathing problems are the common symptoms of heat-related illness, said the ministry.

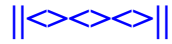


The government has issued directions to Telecom Service Providers (TSPs) for blocking incoming international spoofed calls. In a statement, the Ministry of Communications informed that fraudsters are making international spoofed calls displaying Indian mobile numbers to Indian citizens and committing cyber-crime and financial frauds. These calls appear to be originating within India but being made by the cyber-criminals from abroad by manipulating the calling line identity. The ministry said that these calls have been misused in recent cases of fake digital arrests, Fed Ex scams, drugs/narcotics in courier, impersonation as government and police officials, disconnections of mobiles numbers by DoTs/TRAI officials, etc. It noted that together with the Department of Telecommunications, the TSPs have devised a system to help identify and block incoming international spoofed calls from reaching any Indian telecom subscriber.

Hamas says, it has launched a big rocket attack at the Tel Aviv area in central Israel. The Israeli military said, at least eight rockets were launched from the Rafah area in southern Gaza and several were intercepted. No injuries were reported. The attack, the first time in nearly four months that Hamas has attacked central Israel, comes as Israel carries out a military operation in Rafah, defying a ruling by the UN's top court.



In the final of IPL Cricket, Kolkata Knight Riders (KKR) defeated Sunrisers Hyderabad (SRH) by 8 wickets at MA Chidambaram Stadium in Chennai last night. Chasing a paltry target of 114 runs set by SRH, KKR scored 114 for 2 in just 10.3 overs. For KKR, Venkatesh Iyer was the top scorer with an unbeaten 52 runs followed by Rahmanullah Gurbaz who scored 39 runs. Earlier, SRH won the toss and elected to bat first. SRH were all out for 113 runs in 18.3 overs. For SRH, skipper Pat Cummins was the highest scorer with 24 runs. For KKR, Andre Russell scalped 3 wickets. Mitchell Starc was declared Player of the Match.
