The World Health Organization (WHO) has launched a new 'Investment Round' aiming to raise 7 billion dollars of funds to support countries to tackle challenges like climate change, displacement, poverty and inequality. In a social media post, WHO Chief Tedros Adhanom Ghebreyesus said that the world is facing a difficult time with multiple challenges. He said the Investment Round aims to mobilize 7 billion dollars over four years to support countries to respond to these challenges. The Investment Round is the result of recommendations by the WHO Working Group on Sustainable Financing and was approved at the 154th Meeting of the WHO Executive Board in January 2024.

Department of Telecommunications and Ministry of Home Affairs has taken action to protect citizens from potential SMS fraud through the Sanchar Saathi initiative. The Ministry of Communications said, it was noted that more than ten thousand fraudulent messages were sent using eight SMS Headers for sending fraudulent communications in the past three months. It said, the Principal Entities which were owners of these eight SMS Headers were blacklisted. All the 73 SMS Headers and one thousand 522 SMS content templates owned by these Principal Entities have been blacklisted.

The India Meteorological Department, IMD has forecast above normal rainfall over the country as a whole during the monsoon season this year. Director General, IMD Dr Mrutyunjay Mohapatra said this while releasing the second Stage of Long Range Forecast of Southwest Monsoon. Dr Mohapatra further informed that conditions are favourable for onset of monsoon over Kerala and North-Eastern states in the next five days.

Director General of the National Disaster Response Force, Piyush Anand has said that the NDRF is a 24×7 ready force and the relief teams are dispatched within 30 minutes after receiving the emergency call. In an exclusive interview with the Akashvani News, DG, NDRF added that disaster management is a manpower-intensive activity. He appealed to the citizens to come forward and volunteer for the noble cause.

With the aim to promote awareness about the importance of oral hygiene and encourage preventive Dental Care and fostering a culture of healthy food habits, Children Dental Health Month was observed yesterday at Government Primary School Yongnyah Sector-C, Longleng. Dental Surgeon District Hospital Longleng, Dr. Chumei Nyam encouraged the children to brush their teeth twice a day and limit sugar intake. She urged them to eat more fruits and vegetables and to avoid tobacco products. Dr Nyam also demonstrated the brushing techniques. District Nodal Officer of National Oral Health Program Longleng Nichukholie Vupru, spoke on the importance of oral health and encouraged the students and parents present to make a habit of visiting dentist regularly.

Students received free toothbrush, toothpaste and IEC material on oral health.
