Prime Minister Narendra Modi today expressed gratitude to the people for reiterating their faith in the Constitution and the democratic systems of the country in the Lok Sabha elections. Addressing the nation in his Mann ki Baat programme on Akashvani this morning, the Prime Minister highlighted that the 2024 General Elections were the biggest elections in the world in which 65 crore people cast their votes. Prime Minister in his 112th Maan Ki Baat highlighted about 'Hool Diwas' celebrated in Jharkhand, 'Ek Ped Maa Ke Naam', 'Karthumbhi Umbrella' of Kerala, Araku coffee of Andhra Pradesh, snow peas of Jammu and Kashmir, Hindi programme in Kuwait National Radio in his speech. The Prime Minister also congratulated the Akashvani family as the Sanskrit Bulletin of Akashvani is completing 50 years of its broadcast today.

Rohit Sharma led Team India clinched the ICC Men's T20 cricket World Cup 2024 defeating South Africa by seven runs in a classic final at Kensington Oval last night. Opting to bat first, Virat Kohli's 76 and Axar Patel's 47 led India to a strong 176 for 7 in 20 overs, the highest score by any team in the final of a men's T20 World Cup. Chasing the target of 177 runs, South Africa could only score 169 runs losing eight wickets with the help of Heinrich Klaasen's 52 runs. For India, Hardik Pandya picked up three wickets while Jasprit Bumrah and Arshdeep Singh bagged two wickets each. Virat Kohli was declared the Player of the Match award and Jaspreet Bumrah was awarded the Player of the Tournament. However, Virat Kohli and Rohit Sharma – announced their retirement from T20 International after the side's second T20 World Cup win.

The President, Vice President and Prime Minister have congratulated the Indian team for winning the T20 World Cup 2024. President Droupadi Murmu in a social media post said, with the never-say-die spirit, the team sailed through difficult situations and demonstrated outstanding skills throughout the tournament. Vice President Jagdeep Dhankhar in a social media post, said, Bharat is elated by the spectacular victory of the Men in Blue in the T20 World Cup. Prime Minister Narendra Modi posted a video message just after team India won the final and said that the country is proud of the Indian Cricket Team.

Surface communication to several districts of Arunachal Pradesh was snapped following landslides triggered by incessant rain, officials said on Saturday. A key stretch from Aalo in West Siang district to Mechukha in Shi-Yomi district was damaged in between Roing and Pene villages due to the continuous downpour, they said. The Pasighat-Pangin-Aalo road has also been damaged near Tarak village in Siang district, with many vehicles getting stranded, he said. In another incident in Itanagar, a school bus of Sri Sri Ravishankar Vidyamandir met with an accident on Saturday due to a landslide. The incident took place at 3:15 pm near the NES building in Richi, Jollang. Two teachers from the school, along with the bus driver, received minor injuries.

The India Meteorological Department on Saturday predicted heavy to very heavy rainfall in northwest and Northeast India over the next four to five days. As per the weather forecast Tirap, Changlang, Longding, East Siang, Namsai, Lohit, Papumpare, and Dibang Valley may witness heavy rainfall till 5th July.

The ICR district administration on Saturday evicted the street vendors at 6 Kilo area, along NH 415, and demolished their temporary sheds constructed over the drains. The eviction drive was carried out as the vendors had not complied with the notice issued to them to shift to safer areas. DC Capital Itanagar Shweta Nagarkoti Mehta in a press statement said that despite these warnings, the vendors were still continuing to run their outlets and hence it was necessary to carry out the eviction to prevent potential accidents and ensure everyone's safety.

As the state government prepares to implement three new criminal laws in the state from tomorrow, the District Administration Capital Itanagar conducted a refresher course for all Executive Magistrates, Special Magistrates, and Judicial Branch staff in the Conference Hall of the DC office yesterday. DC Capital Itanagar Shweta Nagarkoti Mehta, encouraged all officers and staff to take full advantage of this opportunity to familiarize themselves with the new criminal laws. EAC Khoda Lasa, the resource person for the session, presented a detailed in-depth explanation of the new laws. The training session included group discussions and a question-andanswer round, providing a comprehensive understanding of the changes.

Rajiv Gandhi University here has been ranked 13th in the list of central universities released by the Indian Institutional Ranking Framework, topping in the Northeast region. Mizoram University secured the 15th position, followed by Tezpur University, and NEHU, Shillong at the 16th and 18th positions among the list of 50 other central varsities in the country. RGU Vice-Chancellor Prof Saket Kushwaha congratulated the university fraternity on the ranking by the IIRF.

Three of India's greatest ever cricketers – Virat Kohli, Rohit Sharma and Ravindra Jadeja – announced their retirement from T20 International Cricket after India's second T20 World Cup win on Saturday night at Kensington Oval. Kohli announced his retirement minutes after the triumph, India captain Rohit Sharma announced it in the official post-match press conference. Kohli played 125 T20 international matches and scored 4188 runs. While Rohit Sharma played 159 T20 international matches and scored 4231 runs. Jadeja, who is regarded as an outstanding fielder of world cricket, announced his retirement on Sunday, played 74 T20 International matches and took 54 wickets and scored 515 runs.

The Central Bureau of Investigation today interrogated the accused at Beur Central Jail in Patna, Bihar, in the alleged question paper leak case of the NEET UG examination. This marks the second Central consecutive day that the Agency has conducted interrogations at Patna Jail in this case. So far, the agency has arrested five suspects from Bihar and Jharkhand. The Central Agency is also questioning 13 other accused who are lodged in Beur Jail; they were previously arrested by the Economic Offence Unit of Bihar Police. The CBI took over the case on June 24th from the EOU.
