Arunachal Pradesh Chief Minister Pema Khandu on Friday congratulated Prime Minister Narendra Modi on being elected as the leader of NDA Parliamentary Party, BJP Parliamentary Party, and the leader of the Lok Sabha. The National Testing Agency (NTA) has said that the whole process of the National Eligibility-cum-Entrance Test (NEET-UG) 2024 has been very transparent and the integrity of the examination throughout the country was not compromised. The examination was held on 5th of May and the result was declared on 4th of June. Addressing media in New Delhi over the issues raised by the candidates, Director General, NTA Subodh Kumar Singh said that there was no paper leak. He said, the issue concerning the NEET exam is related to six centers and 1,600 candidates who have lost their time due to wrong distribution of question paper. He said, the NTA has formed a high-powered committee to analyze the grievances of these 1,600.
