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Nagaland Government has constituted a Political Affairs Committee (PAC) to review and discuss all major issues relating to Nagaland political issue. In a notification issued on 5th June, the PAC will comprise of 26 members of the Nagaland Legislative Assembly and the two MPs S Phangnon Konyak and MP Lok Sabha S Supongmeren Jamir. The PAC will be headed by Chief Minister Neiphiu Rio as the Convener, and Minister for Power & Parliamentary Affairs KG Kenye, as Member Secretary.

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Governor of Nagaland La Ganesan held a review meeting at Raj Bhavan yesterday. The meeting was held with the Chief Engineer of Construction, Malingaon, and Deputy Chief Engineers of NFR to discuss the Dhansari Zubza (Kohima) Railway project and the redevelopment of Dimapur Railway Station.

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The Chief Secretary of Nagaland has convened an emergency meeting today in the Conference Hall of the Chief Secretary, Civil Secretariat, Kohima at 10:30 AM. The meeting was called to examine and undertake specific measures for the prevention and mitigation of environmental hazards caused by the irresponsible disposal of solid wastes in the upstream of Doyang Dam Reservoir, North Eastern Electric Power Cooperation Limited NEEPCO. In addition, the Chairman of District Disaster Management Authority Wokha and HOP NEEPCO at Doyang to submit preliminary report by 10 AM today.

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The Rising People's Party, RPP has reminded and urged the state government to release ex-gratia payments to the three IRB personnel who died during the election duty in the country. The RPP said the release of ex-gratia payments should be within 10 days after the counting process. The RPP stated that as directed by Election Commission of India, ex-gratia payment amounting to 15 lakh per rupees deceased personnel/polling officers etc., should be paid on or before June 14 by the state government. It also added that the same amount would be reimbursed by the central government at a later date and no expense is to be borne by the state government. Apart from the urgency to make the payments on or before June 14, the RPP also urged the state government to give gainful employment to the relatives of the deceased. Meanwhile, the RPP, meanwhile, questioned the NDPP-BJP coalition as to why there has been no public response to the fact that TA/DA of 1500 rupees was reduced to 550 rupees knowing the fact that our police personnel were going to be operating in a very hostile environment for several months in sweltering heat in India. To this, the RPP said the state government owes an appropriate answer to the brave jawans.

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Chief Election Commissioner Rajeev Kumar, accompanied by Election Commissioners Gyanesh Kumar and Dr. Sukhbir Singh Sandhu met President Droupadi Murmu at Rashtrapati

Bhawan yesterday evening. They submitted a copy of the Notification issued by the Election Commission, which contains the names of the Members elected to the Lok Sabha following the General Elections to the 18th Lok Sabha, to the President. President Murmu congratulated the Chief Election Commissioner and the Election Commissioners on the successful completion of the electoral process. Speaking to media after submitting the list to the President, the Chief Election Commissioner said, with this, the process for the formation of the 18th Lok Sabha has been completed from their side.



The poll panel yesterday lifted the Model Code of Conduct (MCC) following the announcement of results of Lok Sabha polls. The Model Code of Conduct had come into force on the 16th of March with the announcement of Lok Sabha polls. However, the Model Code of Conduct is still in force in Graduates' and Teachers' Constituencies of Karnataka, Maharashtra and Telangana due to biennial/bye elections to the Legislative Council from Graduates' and Teachers' Constituencies.



Haryana Police has secured the first position in the country in blocking mobile numbers involved in cyber crime. According to the National Cyber Crime Reporting Portal, a total of 5 lakh 46 thousand mobile numbers involved in cyber crime were blocked across the country from 1st January to 31st April this year, out of which 1 lakh 11 thousand 349 mobile numbers were blocked by Haryana Police. Director General of Police Shatrujeet Kapoor said that this is the second major achievement of Haryana Police at the national level regarding cyber crime control.
