The government has termed a WhatsApp message which claimed that the Agnipath Scheme has been re-launched as the Sainik Saman Scheme as fake. The message doing rounds claims that the scheme has been re-launched with several changes including the duty period being extended to seven years, 60 per cent permanent staff and increased income. The Press Information Bureau has clarified that no such decision has been taken by the Center.

Eight people have been killed and 50 injured after two compartments of the Sealdah-bound Kanchanjunga Express derailed following a collision with a goods train near New Jalpaiguri station in West Bengal this morning. Railway sources said a container train overshot the signal and hit the rear portion of the Kanchanjunga Express, which had two parcel vans and a guard coach in the rear. President Droupadi Murmu and Prime Minister Narendra Modi has expressed grief over the tragic train accident in Darjeeling, West Bengal. In a social media post, President Murmu said, the news of the loss of lives due to a train accident in Darjeeling is deeply distressing. The President said, her thoughts and prayers are with the bereaved families. In a social media post, the Prime Minister said, the railway accident in West Bengal is saddening. He paid condolences to those who lost their loved ones and prayed that the injured recover at the earliest. He also spoke to the officials and took stock of the situation and said that rescue operations are underway to assist the affected. The Prime Minister also announced an ex-Gratia Of 2 Lakh Rupees For Each Deceased Person's Kin and 50.000 Rupees for all who were injured in the mishap.

Union Railway Minister Ashwini Vaishnaw rushed to the train mishap spot in West Bengal's Darjeeling district today, hours after a goods train hit the Silchar-Kolkata Kanchanjunga Express, killing at least nine persons. After reaching the accident site close to the Rangapani railway station near New Jalpaiguri, the Union Minister took stock of the situation and said that a thorough probe would be conducted to find out the reasons behind the lapses. The Union Minister said that restoration of the route is the top priority now and a report from the Commissioner of Railway Safety was awaited, which may give some insights into the reasons behind the accident. Meanwhile, the Centre has announced an ex-gratia of 10 lakh rupees each for the families of those killed in the accident, while 2.5 lakh rupees and 50,000 rupees were announced for those with grievous and minor injuries, respectively.
