Phek district unit of Nagaland Contractors' and Suppliers' Union has flagged the protracted neglect of the 2-lane road stretch between Chakhabama and Kikruma. The road is the main route for Phek and Kiphire districts for transport of essential commodities as well as travelling. However, it has been in deplorable condition for the last three to four years, the Union said. It said the project was carried out under the initiative of NHIDCL, with initial work allotted to KCPL Company. The Union claimed that KCPL did not execute the construction work properly but abandoned the work for many years. The work was later handed to another company named Ratna, which has also delayed and neglected the works for many years along this stretch, the union alleged. Condemning the prolonged negligence, the union has urged Ratna Company to expedite the construction work before the onset of monsoon. The union cautioned that the Company would be held responsible for any damages caused to vehicles or loss of lives due to its negligence in manning the road condition properly. The union further appealed for the immediate intervention of the District Administration in the matter for the welfare of the people. Stressing upon the quality of workmanship as per specifications of the work, the union warned that should the Company and Administration fail to attend to the issue, it would be obligated to take its own course of action.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi yesterday held a meeting to review the heatwave related situation in the country. In the meeting, the Prime Minister was briefed that as per IMD forecasts, heat wave is likely to continue in parts of Rajasthan, Gujarat and Madhya Pradesh. This year, the monsoon is likely to be normal and above normal in most parts of the country and below normal in parts of Peninsular India. Modi instructed that proper drills for preventing and handling incidents of fire must be done on a regular basis. Fire audit and electrical safety audit of hospitals and other public places must be undertaken regularly. The Prime Minister also said that regular drills for the maintenance of fire-line in forests and productive utilization of the biomass must be planned.
