The swearing-in ceremony for the new government at the Centre will take place at Rashtrapati Bhawan this evening. President Droupadi Murmu has invited Prime Minister-designate Narendra Modi to form the new government. The swearing-in ceremony will be held at 7:15 PM in the evening. The President will administer the Oath of Office and Secrecy to Modi and the members of Union Council of Ministers. Several leaders from neighbouring countries have been invited to attend the swearing-in ceremony of Narendra Modi, who is set to become the Prime Minister for a third consecutive term. Akashvani, Delhi will broadcast the running commentary of the ceremony from Rashtrapati Bhawan from 6:45 PM onwards on its FM Gold, Indraprastha and Akashvani Live News 24X7 Channels. This broadcast will also be livestreamed on Akashvani AIR. the YouTube channel of Akashvani.

According to Congress party members, the registration was filed by the MP election yesterday at Lok Sabha Secretariat in New Delhi. Jamir was accompanied by Nagaland Pradesh Congress Committee leaders Khriedi Theunuo and GK Zhimomi.

Clean Doyang Mission initiated for clearing solid wastes accumulated at Doyang Dam Reservoir, NEEPCO began yesterday. The teams for the mission are District Disaster Management Authority, Wokha Divisional Forest Department, Fishery Department, Water Resource, NEPCO and EAC which was constituted by Deputy Commissioner, Wokha Ajit Kumar Ranjan earlier. A meeting was held among the stakeholders, village council members and representatives from various villages along with Deputy Commissioner of Wokha, Ajit Kumar Ranjan and Wokha SP in the evening. Ranjan informed that the mission will continue for next few days as part of a short term exercise. He said long term plans are being planned. The DC called the local community to generate more awareness on solid wastes and assured to extend full support to take it forward. Ranjan also reminded on the need to recognise the significance of the reservoir as a valuable asset for which it was everyone's responsibility to protect and preserve it. The DC encouraged government agencies and the local community to collectively work together.

The United Nations has included Israel and Hamas in its annual "list of shame," part of a report documenting violations against children in armed conflicts. This is the first time both entities have appeared on this list, which already features groups and nations such as Russia, the Islamic State, al-Qaeda, Boko Haram, Afghanistan, Iraq, Myanmar, Somalia, Yemen, and Syria. The inclusion of Israel is particularly notable, as it marks the first time a democratic country has been listed. The decision stems from allegations of rights violations against children during armed conflicts.

As part of the ongoing orientation programme of Police on new Criminal Laws, 2024, a programme was conducted for 15th NAP, IR Mahila Batallion at Chumoukedima yesterday. The resource person Chief Judicial Magistrate cum Secretary Dimapur District legal Services Authority Seyielenuo Mezhü sensitized the participants about the Bharatiya Nagarik Suraksha Sanhita, Bharatiya Nyaya Sanhita and Bhartiya Sakshya Adhiniyam. The new laws replaces the earlier criminal laws including Indian Penal Code, IPC 1860, Code of Criminal Procedure, CrPC, 1973 and Indian Evidence Act, 1872. In a separate programme organized by DEF Kiphire, Chief Judicial Magistrate cum Secretary Kiphire DLSA, Holika Sukhalu spoke as resource person. The workshop was attended by officers from 14th NAP, Pungro, Seyochung and Kiphire Police station.
