Counting of votes for Lok Sabha elections 2024 and State Legislative Assemblies of Andhra Pradesh and Odisha and bye-elections to Assembly Constituencies will be held on Tuesday starting 8 AM onwards. The counting of votes for Assembly elections of Sikkim and Arunachal Pradesh have begun this morning. Arunachal Pradesh has 60 Assembly seats, out of which BJP has already won 10 seats uncontested.
