10th International Day of Yoga is being celebrated across the country today. This year's theme, Yoga for Self and Society, emphasizes yoga's vital role in fostering both individual well-being and societal harmony. This year also marks the 10th anniversary which was proposed by Prime Minister Narendra Modi at the United Nations General Assembly in 2014. Prime minister Modi led the International Yoga Day Celebrations at SKICC this morning in honour of the 10th International Day of Yoga along with 7000 participants.



The 10th International Day of Yoga is also being celebrated across the state of Nagaland. In Kohima, Department of Youth Resources and Sports in collaboration with National AYUSH Mission, Directorate of Health & Family Welfare, Nagaland is organising the event at IG Stadium Kohima this morning with participation from students from IG Academy, NYK, NCC Girls Battalion. State Nodal Officer, National AYUSH Mission, Directorate of Health & Family Welfare, Nagaland Dr. Seyiekhrietuo John led the participants in performing the common Yoga Protocol such as Asana, breathing technique and meditation. On the occasion. Dr John also spoke the significance of the Yoga in the occasion. In addition, the state tourism department is also working organising the event at the Naga Heritage Kisama which will begin at 8 AM.



Governor of Nagaland, La Ganesan has said that celebration of statehood foundation day of West Bengal in Nagaland Is a testament to the spirit of Ek Bharat Shrestha Bharat which aims to strengthen bonds and enrich cultural fabric of our nation. Addressing a programme in Kohima yesterday, the governor said the initiative promotes understanding and respect for the diverse traditions that make up our country. On the occasion, he also extended statehood day greetings to people of West Bengal who have made Nagaland their home. Governor La Ganesan also described West Bengal as a land known for its rich literary heritage, art, music, and cinema. The governor said it has contributed immensely to the cultural and intellectual vibrancy of our nation.



Education Minister Dharmendra Pradhan yesterday said that the government will constitute a high-level committee to look into the issues related to the National Testing Agency. He said, the recommendations of the high-level committee will further improve the functioning of NTA, its structure, functioning, examination process, transparency and data security protocol. Pradhan said, few irregularities

have come to the government's notice and the government takes responsibility for it. He said, it is in touch with the Bihar government with regard to NEET-UG exam. On the cancellation of UGC Net exam, the Minister said, based on the inputs received from the Indian Cyber Crime Coordination Centre, the government decided to cancel the examination.

Commissioner & Secretary, Health & Family welfare, V. Kezo commented that the Coffee table book is a combination of best practices and innovation from different parts of the state. Deputy Commissioner Mon, Ajit Kumar Verma has said that illegal Lottery games which are in contravention to the Lotteries, Regulation Act, 1998 are being sold in various Towns within Mon District. The DC reiterated that any person engaged in sale, distribution or purchasing of tickets of illegal lotteries like Shillong Teer, Nagaland Arrow, Raja Rani among others will be punishable with imprisonment and fine. In this regard, the DC has directed all Administrative Officers in coordination with security agencies to immediately conduct verification within their jurisdiction and shut down all outlets where such illegal lotteries are being sold.
