NEWS IN ORDER:-

KHANDU-OATH:

Pema Khandu will take oath as the Chief Minister of Arunachal Pradesh for the third term in a row along with his council of ministers today at 11 am. BJP national president JP Nadda, Union Home Minister Amit Shah and party's national general secretary (organisation) BL Santhosh will attend the swearing-in ceremony at the Dorjee Khandu Convention Centre, Itanagar. Khandu who was elected as the BJP Legislature Party leader, met the Governor, KT Parnaik at Raj Bhavan in Itanagar yesterday and staked claim to form the government. Subsequently, the Governor invited him to form the new government. During the BJP Legislature Party meeting, Khandu was unanimously elected as the new leader of the legislature party in the presence of BJP central observers, Ravi Shankar Prasad and national general secretary, Tarun Chugh.

DONER:

Jyotiraditya M. Scindia yesterday assumed charge as Union Minister for the Ministry of Development of North Eastern Region. Dr. Majumdar, Minister of State for DoNER along with senior officers of the Ministry welcomed the Union Minister. After assuming charge, Scindia met senior officials of the ministry and reviewed the schemes. Interacting with the media, Scindia said, the Prime Minister has always prioritized the North Eastern region. He also said that it is the government's commitment to accelerate development in the region and establish new benchmarks for modern development.

SESSION:

The first session of the 11th Sikkim Legislative Assembly was held today with Protem Speaker, Sanjeet Kharel in the chair and administered oath or affirmation of membership of the state assembly to the newly elected MLAs of the 32-member state legislature. Election of Speaker and Deputy Speaker of the state assembly was also held yesterday. The House has unanimously elected ruling Sikkim Krantikari Morcha candidate and former minister, Mingma Norbu Sherpa as the new Speaker and its party MLA, Rajkumari Thapa as the Deputy Speaker. The SKM retained power in the State for its second term winning 31 out of 32 seats in the just concluded state assembly election.
