### **HEADLINES:-**

- ✓ Swearing-in ceremony of new government at Centre will take place at Rashtrapati Bhawan today evening at 7.15 PM; leaders of neighbouring countries arrive in New Delhi to attend swearing-in ceremony of Narendra Modi and his council of ministers.
- ✓ Swearing-in ceremony of Prem Singh Tamang as Chief Minister of Sikkim for second consecutive term and his Council of Ministers will be held at Paljor Stadium in Gangtok on Monday at 4 PM.

### **SWEARING-IN:**

The swearing-in ceremony of the new government at the Centre will take place at Rashtrapati Bhawan today evening at 7.15 PM. President Droupadi Murmu has invited Prime Minister-designate Narendra Modi to form the new government. The President will administer an oath of office and secrecy to Modi and the members of Union Council of Ministers. Akashvani correspondent reports that several leaders from neighbouring countries have been invited to attend the swearing-in ceremony of Narendra Modi, who is set to become the Prime Minister for the third consecutive term. President of Sri Lanka, Ranil Wickremesinghe, President of Maldives, Dr. Mohamed Muizzu, Vice-President of Seychelles, Ahmed Afif and Prime Minister of Bangladesh, Sheikh Hasina, Prime Minister of Mauritius, Pravind Kumar Jugnauth, Prime Minister of Nepal, Pushpa Kamal Dahal 'Prachanda' and Prime Minister of Bhutan, Tshering Tobgay will attend the ceremony. The Leaders have started arriving in New Delhi including the Prime Minister of Bangladesh Sheikh Hasina and Vice President of Seychelles Ahmed Afif. In addition to participating in the swearing-in ceremony, the leaders will also attend a Banquet hosted by President Droupadi Murmu at the Rashtrapati Bhavan. Delhi Police has taken stringent measures to ensure security during the event.

### **TAMANG:**

The swearing-in ceremony of Prem Singh Tamang as the Chief Minister of Sikkim for the second consecutive term and his Council of Ministers will be held tomorrow at 4 PM. The ceremony will be held at Paljor Stadium in Gangtok. Governor Lakshman Prasad Acharya will administer an oath of office and secrecy to Tamang and his Council of Ministers. Former Governor, Ganga Prasad is also attending the swearing-in ceremony. Tamang has led the Sikkim Krantikari

Morcha (SKM) retained power for its second term with a thumping majority winning 31 out of 32 seats in the Sikkim Legislative Assembly Elections, 2024. The Sikkim Democratic Front could get just one seat with its President and former Chief Minister Pawan Kumar Chamling getting defeated in both the Assembly seats he had contested. Both the newly formed Citizen Action Party and Congress also could not open their electoral accounts this time. All four female candidates of SKM - Raj Kumari Thapa, Krishna Kumari Rai, Kala Rai and Pamin Lepcha also won with comfortable margins in this election. Meanwhile all government and private schools, colleges, and academic institutions within Gangtok Municipal Corporation will be closed on the day of the swearing-in ceremony. This decision, announced by the Additional Chief Secretary of the Education Department, aims to accommodate the security arrangements and vehicle movement restrictions in the area.

**LO:**

An Extended Congress Working Committee of the All India Congress Committee has unanimously passed a resolution requesting Rahul Gandhi to assume the role of Leader of Opposition in the Lok Sabha. Addressing a press conference after the CWC meeting in New Delhi yesterday, Senior Congress leader K.C. Venugopal said that the CWC believes Rahul Gandhi's leadership will build a strong and vigilant opposition. Senior Congress leader Jairam Ramesh added that the recent elections serve as a booster dose for the Congress party.

**ADVISORY:**

The office of the Mission Director, National Health Mission (NHM) has issued an advisory listing expected symptoms after consumption of poisonous mushrooms which may lead to upset stomach (nausea, vomiting, and cramps) and in severe cases victims feel thirsty, sweating, hallucinations, coma and liver damage. It said that the lack of knowledge can increase the risk of accidental consumption of toxic mushrooms, leading to severe health consequences. It also advised citizens to never eat a wild mushroom especially if the identity of the mushroom is in doubt or unknown. So far 27 cases of mushroom poisoning have been reported in the state this year with the loss of four lives due consumption of the wild fungus.

**TOURISM:**

Meghalaya Tourism Minister, Paul Lyngdoh inaugurated the Cluster Development Fund Project at Lum Symper yesterday, in the presence of Mawsynram MLA Ollan Singh Suin, Dy CEM KHADC, P.N Syiem, MDC Alvin K Sawkmie, officials from the MBMA, CLLMP and others. Speaking at the gathering, Lyngdoh appreciated the Raid Saw Symper for the initiatives of preserving the environment. He said, this day should remind us that if we talk about development we should see the development that's sustained, the development that comes through destroying the environment, is not development but it's a development that crawls. He also said that there is no development that happen without cooperating with the society. He also said that it should be a wake up and remind the youth that this earth that we live on doesn't belong to us, but need to take care and hand it over to our children.
