Prime Minister Narendra Modi today addressed the nation through his Mann ki baat programe on Akashvani. Mr Modi has expressed his pride that Charaideo Maidam of Assam is being included in the UNESCO World Heritage Sites. He said it will be the 43rd site of India in the list, and the first Cultural World Heritage site from the Northeast. Touching upon the challenge of drug menace, Prime Minister informed that the government has taken a special initiative called MANAS, which is a step in the fight against drug abuse. The Helpline and Portal of MANAS were launched recently and a toll-free number-1933-has been issued. He also asked listeners to participate in the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign, with 15th August approaching, he encouraged people to upload their selfies with the Tricolour on 'harghartiranga.com'. He also sought their suggestions ahead of Independence Day on MyGov or NaMo App.

In Paris Olympics, shooter Manu Bhaker has begged the medal for India. She won Bronze Medal in the women's 10 meter air pistol category and became the first female Indian Shooter to win a medal in the Olympics. Earlier, today, in badminton, PV Sindhu won her first group stage match. She beat FN Abdul Razzaq of Maldives 21-9, 21-6. In Rowing, Balraj Panwar qualified for the quarter finals in the Men's Single Scull. Shooter Ramita Jindal qualified for 10m Women's Air Rifle final. In Table Tennis Women's Singles, Sreeja Akula defeated Sweden's Christina Kallberg and enters the Round of 32. Yesterday, Indian men's hockey team kickstarted their campaign with a 3-2 wins against New Zealand in the opening Pool-B match last night. In badminton men's doubles, the pair of Chirag Shetty and Satwiksairaj Rankireddy registered a comfortable win in their first group stage match.
