Mr. Modi praised the people of the country for showing maturity and wisdom in the General Election. He also said his government has been working with a mantra of 'Sabka Saath Sabka Vikas.'

Union Public Service Commission has announced the results of Civil Services Preliminary exam 2024. The qualified candidates will have to apply again in the Detailed Application Form-I (DAF-I) for the Civil Services (Main) Examination, 2024. Meanwhile, the dates for filling up of the application and its submission will be announced in due course on the Commission's website.

The Dibang Valley district administration team has been recognized as one of the top 30 performing districts in India for the successful implementation of the joint action plan to prevent child drug abuse and illicit trafficking by National Commission for Protection of Child Rights.

Deputy Commissioner Capital, Shweta Nagarkoti Mehta, has taken various measures to curb the problems of the road blockages, landslides and mudslides reported from various areas due to incessant rainfall in Capital Itanagar. She urged all residents to remain vigilant and take necessary precautions to ensure their safety especially those residing in vulnerable areas to move to safer locations or at designated relief camps. Alerts and advisories are being issued repeatedly. The DC has also ordered the closure of all schools in the Capital Itanagar for five days starting from today till the 6<sup>th</sup> of this month. Meanwhile, the District Administration Capital Itanagar is also actively engaged in road maintenance, clearing drains and blockages with all concerned departments.

Incessant rain continues to affect normal life in Arunachal Pradesh. Landslides and flash flood triggered by heavy rainfall have blocked road communication to many interior places. In Lohit

district, the District Administration has evacuated 52 people from various flood affected areas in the district. Meanwhile, in Upper Siang District, the road restoration work is in progress at Geying village block point Pasighat -Yingkiong Road and will take more than 10 days depending on the weather conditions.

MLA Oken Tayeng accompanied by Deputy Commissioner East Siang Tayi Taggu and ADC Mebo Sibbo Passing inspected all the affected flood prone areas under Mebo-Sub division yesterday. The MLA also interacted with the GBs, Panchayat leaders and other village members of Sigar, Borguli, Kongkul, Namsing, Mer and Gadum. Further, the team took stock of the relief and emergency measures such as medicines stock, ration items, restoration of connectivity, etc. and stressed for regular advisories issued at village and Circle level for safety of the people.

The online self-nominations from eligible teachers for National Teachers' Awards 2024 are being invited from 27<sup>th</sup> June 2024 on the Ministry of Education's portal. The last date for receiving online nominations is 15<sup>th</sup> of this month. This year, 50 teachers will be selected through the three-stage selection process at the District, State and National level. The award will be conferred by the President of India on 5<sup>th</sup> September 2024 at a ceremony held at Vigyan Bhawan, New Delhi.

The Government has sought suggestions and response from students and parents to develop robust mechanisms in the National Testing Agency. Students and Parents can send their response till the 7<sup>th</sup> of this month to the committee.

The One-Time Registration (OTR) application is now live and accessible to the public, allowing students to conveniently register online for OTR on the National Scholarship Portal (NSP). The last date for submission of fresh/renewal applications for National Means Cum-Merit Scholarship (NMMSS) by students for 2024-25 on NSP is 31<sup>st</sup> August 2024.

Miss Gopi Bam has won a gold medal in arm wrestling competition in the 65 kg category at the 48<sup>th</sup> National Arm Sports Championship held in Maharashtra. While Mr. Rakesh Jomyang has won a gold and a silver medal, in the 55 kg weight category.
