World Population Day was observed under the theme ‘Healthy timing and spacing of pregnancies for wellbeing of mother and child’ at CMO Conference hall, Wokha today. Delivering the welcome address, Chief Medical Officer Wokha, Dr. Zubenthung Kikon informed that more family planning activities will be implemented in the days to come as part of World Population Day and stabilization fortnight in the district. In his speech, ADC Wokha, K. Furhesie Nyuwi, highlighted the involvement of local factors in implementing such health programme. He said the increasing population is a concern to everyone taking in to account the limited resources available in the state. Theme speaker, DPO (RCH/UIP) Wokha, Dr. Thungchanpeni Patton, said as per the Ministry of Health & Family Welfare, the theme emphasized on women empowerment to achieve population growth. She informed on the types of family planning

methods available in health centres and sought the support of civil societies, line department and communities to promote family planning.

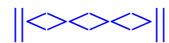


Tening Town Council launched Safai Apnao, Bimari Bhagao campaign at Tening in Peren district, Nagaland. ADC & Administrator, T. Lemlila Sangtam in her keynote address highlighted the pressing issues for proper waste management stressing on minimising waste at household level so as to achieve a greener, cleaner and healthier town. The programme included action plan on cleanliness drive, mass awareness at Ward level by Swachata Captains and Health Camp for Sanitation Workers at CHC Tening. The launching programme was attended by elected councillors from the nine wards, Swachata Captains of the Wards and Tening Town Council Sanitation Workers. The Safai Apnao, Bimari Bhagao campaign is an initiative to prepare Tening Town during months of heavy rainfall to prevent water-borne and vector-borne diseases in alignment with the ‘Stop Diarrhoea Campaign’.



Zunheboto District Planning & Development Board, DPDB today approved and sent the proposal for inclusion of Sutsa (Sumi language) at B.A or degree level course. The Zunheboto DPDB members made the decision during a meeting held at DC’s conference hall. They also discussed opening of JNV institute at Tokiye block Aghunato; financial assistance for OST center at district hospital; registration of VK range students union and recognition of Viza village at Suruhuto. The proposals were approved to be sent to higher authority for further necessary action. Newly assigned Zunheboto DPDB Chairman, MLA, Picto Shohe, in his speech, requested all the members to work sincerely and cooperate to make Zunheboto one of the best performing districts in Nagaland. He also encouraged the board members to work together and bring about change in the society. Advisor for Food & Civil supplies and Legal Metrology K. T. Sukhalu while informing that the government is taking up various measures to

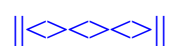
contain any malpractices in the functioning of offices advised the officers to be in station and work sincerely for the welfare of the people.



Advisor for Animal Husbandry & Veterinary Services, Kazheto Kinimi today inaugurated the Office Complex of the Chief Veterinary Officer & Veterinary Hospital, Tseminyu. Speaking on the occasion, Advisor, Kazheto Kinimi called on the people to take ownership and safeguard the infrastructure. He appealed to the people to realise the potential of dairy farming in Nagaland as it can provide gainful employment to various sections of society and make the State self-sufficient in milk production, egg production, poultry, livestock and meat production. Encouraging the people in dairy farming and livestock rearing, Kinimi said a veterinary hospital in a district will result in better care and health of the livestock and poultry, which in turn will translate to better productivity and income.



Deputy Commissioner, Peren, Vineet Kumar has informed that the date before which construction activity at Peren Headquarter has to be started by the private allottees has been extended till 31st of December this year. He said that Peren Head Quarter is envisaged to be developed as a model township and private individuals were allotted land after approval of SLAA to develop and increase settlement and population in the area. In this, he pointed that despite the lapse of sufficient time, several allottees have not started the construction at the allotted site. Therefore, the DC in pursuance of the June 14 DPDB resolution, informed all concerned to comply with extended date after which cancellation of allotment will be carried out.



The Department of Agriculture under SDAO Tizit held a machinery distribution program for palm oil farmers under NMEO-OP 2023-24 at Tizit, Mon today. SDO (Civil) Tizit, Tumben P Tsanglao as the special guest encouraged the

farmers to sincerely maintain the fields as per the guidelines so as to increase the Fresh Fruit Punch, FFP production. He further reminded the farmers to enhance/increase the area through department and the Patanjali company's support. Machineries distributed during the programme include, HP Water Pump, brush cutters, harvester, Power Dealers, Brush Cutters with attachments, Pruning tools and fungicides.



In view of the traffic status in and around Kohima Town, Deputy Commissioner Kohima, Kumar Ramnikant has directed all concerned building owners and shop owners to remove construction materials, abandoned vehicles or any other materials and articles lying along the roadside causing hindrance for free movement of vehicles, traffic and pedestrians within seven days. He said after the dateline all such materials would be removed or seized and fine shall be imposed against violators as per relevant provision of law.



Nagaland Legislative Assembly, NLA has mourned the demise of Late Akukau N. H. Zhetovi Yephthomi, a former member of the State Assembly after prolong illness at CIHSR, Referral Hospital, Dimapur yesterday. In a condolence message, NLA Speaker, Sharingain Longkumer said Late Yephthomi was elected as Member of NLA from Seyochung-Sitimi Assembly Constituency in 1969 and also in 1975 and served as Minister of Animal Husbandry. Longkumer conveyed deepest condolences to the bereaved family and prayed that Almighty God grant solace and comfort to bear the loss. Meanwhile, Nagaland's Lok Sabha MP, S. Supongmeren Jamir while condoling Yephthomi's demise said his untold sacrifices rendered in the service of the people would be difficult to emulate and would be cherished for ages by his constituents and the people of Nagaland in general.
