Government today convened an all-party meeting ahead of the Budget Session of Parliament in Delhi. During the meeting, the government sought cooperation from all political parties to ensure the smooth functioning of both the Houses of Parliament. Union Ministers Rajnath Singh, Kiren Rijiju, Arjun Ram Meghwal, JP Nadda, Chirag Paswan, Ramdas Athawale, and Congress leaders Jairam Ramesh and Gaurav Gogoi, NCP leader Praful Patel, DMK leaders TR Baalu and Tiruchi Siva, Aam Aadmi Party leader Sanjay Singh, AIMIM MP Asaduddin Owaisi were among those who attended the meeting.

Guru Purnima, also known as Vyasa Purnima, is celebrated today across the country, honouring spiritual and academic teachers. On this day, people express gratitude to their Gurus for their wisdom and guidance. It also commemorates Lord Buddha's first sermon after enlightenment, given in Sarnath on the full moon day. Meanwhile, Prime Minister Narendra Modi in a social media post has also extended his greetings to the nation. This festival, falling on the full moon day of Aashaadha month, also marks the birth anniversary of sage Ved Vyasa.

The Government of Arunachal Pradesh and the Arunachal Pradesh Football Association (APFA) received special recognition at the AIFF Awards 2024 in New Delhi on Friday. The award honored their successful organization of the 77th Santosh Trophy 2023-24 held in Yupia. APFA Secretary Kipa Ajay accepted the award from AIFF vice president N.A. Haris. The APFA has also expressed gratitude to Chief Minister Pema Khandu, the Government of Arunachal Pradesh, and all involved for their support in hosting the prestigious football championship.

Former PWD Minister Talo Mugli was laid to rest with full state honours in his Yada, Raga residence on Saturday. The State Government declared a one day mourning, closing all government and educational institutions, as well as markets in Kamle district. Mugli was respected for his leadership within the Nyishi community. He passed away on Thursday after a prolonged illness. He was 67 and is survived by two wives, nine children, and 17 grandchildren.

The Chimpu Police Station team, under the supervision of SP Rohit Rajbir Singh, on Saturday conducted a surprise inspection of shops selling tobacco near schools, including VKV, Sangay Lhaden Sports Academy, and KV No2. The Chimpu PS team seized various tobacco products from these establishments. Meanwhile, Capital Itanagar Deputy Commissioner Talo Potom, who also joined the raid, warned that repeated offenders will face legal action under the Cigarettes and Other Tobacco Products Act (COTPA). The operation aims to ensure a healthier environment for school children, with plans for intensified future raids to enforce compliance.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi today in a social media post has expressed pride that India has come fourth in its best-ever performance in the International Maths Olympiad. Mr Modi said that the contingent has brought home four Gold and one Silver Medal. He stated that this feat will inspire several other youngsters and help make mathematics even more popular.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi today in a social media post has extended birthday wishes to Congress president and Leader of the Opposition in the Rajya Sabha, Mallikarjun Kharge. Mr Modi in his post prayed for Mr. Kharge's long and healthy life.

The Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) has arrested three more persons in connection with the NEET-UG paper leak case. Of them, the two arrested persons are medical students of Bharatpur Medical College in Rajasthan. Sources added that the technical surveillance has confirmed their presence in Hazaribagh of Jharkhand on the day of the NEET-UG examination on the 5th of May. The third arrested person is an 'all-rounder' who was providing all kinds of support to the kingpin.

The Bombay High Court has directed social media intermediaries to take prompt action against deepfake videos of National Stock Exchange (NSE) managing director and CEO giving stock recommendations. Justice R. I. Chagla directed these platforms to remove accounts infringing on NSE's trademark and to submit affidavits detailing such accounts within three weeks. The case will be reviewed again on August 19.

In the Women's Asia Cup T20 Cricket, India paved their way to the semi-finals with second consecutive win in as many matches. India thrashed UAE by 78 runs in the crucial Group A match played at Rangiri Dambulla International Stadium in Sri Lanka. Put in to bat, India amassed a huge score of 201 for 5 breaching the 200 mark in T20Is for the first time. Chasing the target, UAE were restricted to 123 for 7. Richa Ghosh was named the Player of the Match for her unbeaten knock of 64 runs off just 29 balls.
