The Budget Session of Parliament will begin from 22nd of this month. Parliamentary Affairs Minister Kiren Rijiju, in a social media post, informed that the session will continue till 12th August. He said, the Union Budget 2024-25 will be presented in the Lok Sabha on 23rd of this month. Rijiju said, President Droupadi Murmu, on the recommendation of Government of India, has approved the proposal for summoning of both the Houses of Parliament for Budget Session.

President Droupadi Murmu arrived at Bhubaneswar this evening on a four-day visit to Odisha from today. The President was welcomed by Odisha Governor Raghubar Das, Chief Minister Mohan Charan Majhi and other dignitaries at the Biju Patnaik International Airport. The President is visiting her home state to witness the world-famous Rath Yatra of Lord Jaganath, Lord Balabhadra, Devi Subhadra and Lord Sudarshan to be held tomorrow at the holy coastal town of Puri.

The National Board of Examinations in Medical Sciences (NBEMS) conducted the Foreign Medical Graduate Examination (FMGE) June 2024 today. The examination is being held at 71 Centres in 50 cities across the country. All examination centres were monitored through Live CCTV feed.

Health and Family Welfare Minister Biyuram Wahge in his maiden coordination meeting with the Directorate of Health Naharlagun yesterday stressed on improving healthcare delivery system in the State. He suggested all five Directors -Health Services (HS), Family Welfare (FW), Durable Medical Equipment (DME), and Director Tomo Riba Institute of Health & Medical Sciences (TRIHMS) and Mission Director National Health Mission (NHM) to come up with a roadmap for future to improve the health scenario of the State realistically. The Minister also urged for the Health Centre upgradation, new recruitment of Nursing Officers and facility of online appointment with the doctors at TRIHMS to be activated soon. Further, he urged Director TRIHMS Dr Moji Jini to work out on cancer screening and awareness campaign using mass media to reach out the public.

Health Ministry has clarified that news of deferment of NEET UG counselling is incorrect as the date for counselling has not been notified yet. The clarification came amid media reports regarding deferment of NEET UG counselling.

More than 1000 cases were redressed in the first week of special campaign for redressal of family pension grievances. The Department of Pension and Pensioners Welfare launched a monthlong campaign for redressal of Family Pension Grievances on 1<sup>st</sup> of this month for bringing ease in the life of Central Government Family Pensioners. Meanwhile, the top three performers are Department of Ex-Servicemen Welfare, Department of Defence Finance and Ministry of Railways. The campaign will continue till the end of this month.

On the auspicious occasion of His Holiness the 14<sup>th</sup> Dalai Lama's 89th Birth Anniversary, a voluntary blood donation camp was jointly organized today by Arunachal Life Saving Foundation and the State Legislative Assembly in Itanagar. The camp was inaugurated by Speaker Arunachal Pradesh Legislative Assembly (APLA) Tesam Pongte along with the deputy speaker cum senior BJP leader Tai Tagak. The blood donation camp saw participation from National Disaster Response Force (NDRF), including government officials, Central Reserve Police Force (CRPF), police personnel and volunteers from various other organizations.

Changlang DC Vishal Sah along with EAC M Ejing today visited Namtok village and interacted with the Gaon Buras, PRI youths and public to demarcate areas for yet to be establish offices by various departments in there. Further, he also attended 'No Bag Saturday' task and interacted with the students of the Government Secondary School in Namtok. He later also participated in the 75<sup>th</sup> Van Mahotsav plantation drive organized by the Forest department at Yatdam.

The District Level Committee meeting on the One District One Product initiative yesterday at the conference hall of the DC Office in Tawang.
