Chief Minister Pema Khandu said that the state budget 2024-25 is designed to strengthen economy, encourage entrepreneurship, and invest in the youth of the state. He reiterated that it's strategy revolves around the three important pillars of Healthy Human Resources, Robust Infrastructure, and a Vibrant Economy. Taking part in the discussion of the state budget on the last day of the assembly session vesterday, Mr. Khandu said that government has adopted a bottom up approach in the planning process, which gives more power to the districts. He said that the state government has declared the year 2024-25 as the 'Year of the Youth'. The Chief Minister said that the government will soon start third party monitoring of big infrastructure projects to ensure quality works and desired outcome. Deputy Chief Minister Chowna Mein said that the government aims to strengthen good governance, uplift ease of living and doing business, administrative reforms, connectivity, social security, etc. The state assembly passed the annual budget for the financial year 2024-25 through voice vote. Later Speaker Tesam Pongte adjourned the house sine -die.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi visited Kargil War Memorial on the occasion of the 25th Kargil Vijay Diwas today. Mr Modi paid homage to the soldiers who made the supreme sacrifice in the line of duty. In a social media post, Prime Minister said, it is a very special day for every Indian. He said, it is a day to pay homage to all those who protect the nation. Meanwhile, President Droupadi Murmu has also expressed gratitude and paid tribute to the armed forces on Kargil Vijay Diwas. In a social media post, President Murmu acknowledged the extraordinary valour of the Indian armed forces. She remembered and honoured who made the supreme sacrifice while protecting Mother India on the peaks of Kargil in 1999.

Governor Lt. General KT Parnaik(Retd.) celebrated Kargil Vijay Diwas at Raj Bhavan, Itanagar today.
