Prime Minister Narendra Modi today Addressed in the inaugural session of 'Journey Towards Viksit Bharat: A Post Union Budget 2024-25 Conference' in New Delhi, which was organized by the Confederation of Indian Industry (CII) and is aimed at presenting the outline for the Government's larger vision for growth and the industry's role in this endeavor. In the conference Modi said the Govt is focusing on all sectors and said with country's GDP growing at 8 per cent, day is not far for it to become world's third largest economy. PM also said the speed and scale at which the government is building infrastructure is unprecedented. He said that capital expenditure is called the biggest productive medium of resource investment.

In a remarkable feat of modern engineering and resilience, Government Secondary School, Parchin, Itanagar, has become India's first 3D-printed school. The school was rebuilt in just 2 months using state-of-the-art 3D printing technology, after being devoured by fire in November last year, fire destroyed nine class rooms of the school. The school was then compelled to run classes in two shifts in the remaining classrooms. And now with the completion of the structure, full classes have started in the school. Chief Minister Pema Khandu in a social media post has congratulated and complimented everyone engaged in creating a watershed moment in the state's collective efforts to offer a cost-effective, sustainable and rapid solution to educational needs of the students. He said that with the help of this state-of-the-art facility, the government can make education more accessible to remote and underserved communities of the state. State Education Minister Passang Dorjee Sona in social media post said that the educational landscape of Arunachal Pradesh is undergoing a remarkable transformation under the leadership of Chief Minister Pema Khandu.

In Paris Olympics India's Manu Bhaker and Sarabjot Singh clinched Bronze in mixed 10-meter air pistol shooting event by defeating South Korea today. With this win, Manu etched her name in the history of Indian sports by becoming the first Indian athlete to win two medals at the same edition of the Olympics. Sarabjot, on the other hand, got his first Olympic medal. Earlier, Manu won a bronze in the women's 10m Air Pistol event. Meanwhile the Hockey team drew 1-1 with Argentina in a Pool B match yesterday. The Indian team will next face Ireland. Meanwhile in Badminton Lakshya Sen secured his first victory in the Paris Olympics men's singles Group L match, defeating Julien Carraggi of Belgium, he will now face reigning Asian champion Jonatan Christie in his final group match tomorrow. In Men's doubles, India's duo of Satwiksairaj Rankireddy and Chirag Shetty have qualified for the quarterfinals and became the first Indian men's doubles combine to reach the quarterfinals at Olympics.

Arunachal Pradesh Minister for Health and Family Welfare & Water Resources Shri Biyuram Wahge called on Hon'ble Union Minister for Jal Shakti, CR Patil at New Delhi yesterday to discuss on the recent flood situation in the state. Wage highlighted various developmental activities and its achievement in the state to the union Minister.
