In a significant milestone, India and 13 other Indo-Pacific Economic Framework (IPEF) partners have established three supply chain bodies under the landmark Indo-Pacific Economic Framework for Prosperity (IPEF) Agreement relating to Supply Chain Resilience. The inaugural virtual meetings of the Supply Chain Council (SCC), Crisis Response Network (CRN), and Labor Rights Advisory Board (LRAB) marked a major step forward for cooperation among partner countries for strengthening supply chain resilience in the region. Through these inaugural meetings, 14 IPEF partners reaffirmed their commitments and collective resolve to facilitate closer cooperation to strengthen the resilience and competitiveness of critical supply chains and better prepare for and respond to supply chain disruptions that pose a risk to economic prosperity while strengthening labor rights.

Rajiv Gandhi University organized the Youth Festival Red Run (5 Km Mini Marathon) under the Red Ribbon Club and NSS Cell in association with the Arunachal Pradesh State AIDS Control Society in the campus yesterday. The event aimed to create awareness about HIV/AIDS and drug abuse among university students, scholars, teaching, and non-teaching staff. Over 100 participants registered for the event.

Two days State Level Workshop for Wetland Managers and Stakeholders was held at DK convention centre, Itanagar. The workshop deliberated on the theme Integrated Management Planning for Wetlands Conservation and Wise-use. Memorandum of Understanding (MoU) between the Department of Environment, Forest and Climate Change, Govt of Arunachal Pradesh and Wetlands International South Asia was signed.

Civil Aviation Minister Balo Raja conducted an inspection of the under-construction new terminal at the Donyi Polo Airport, today. During the visit, the minister assessed the progress of the construction work, emphasizing the importance of timely completion to meet the growing passenger demand in the region. The new terminal is expected to significantly boost the airport's ability to

handle more passengers from 200 to 400 , reflecting the region's increasing connectivity needs.

District Level Monitoring Committee (DLMC) cum E-Pragati monthly review meeting was conducted yesterday chaired by east siang Deputy Commissioner Tayi Taggu and it was attended by the MLAs of the district. During the meeting the D C instructed the officers to put out all efforts to make East Siang as Front runner district of all developmental indicators. The DC asked all stakeholders to disseminate awareness on various schemes to the targeted beneficiaries. DC emphasize that it is the responsibility of each and every one to deliver last mile services to the people and reach the unreached and cover all target beneficiaries with our sustained and proactive efforts to meet up the expectations of the people in all developmental sectors. Further DC Taggu asked the concerned department to complete projects in time without compromising with work quality and stressed on maximum utilization of limited working period.

As a part of World Hepatitis Day celebration, Tasi Panggeng Community Health Centre, Ruksin on Tuesday conducted Free Hepatitis B & C Screening Test for the vulnerable sections from Murkong selek to Pasihat under Ruksin Sub division. Test was conducted under National Hepatitis Control Programme (NHCP). Altogether 104 tests were conducted out of which only one was screened 'Positive' and rest 103 were negative. IEC activities on transmission, prevention and medical treatment was carried out. Medications for positives are given free under NVHCP. Free Hepatitis B&C test have been made available at FRU Ruksin, which has been designated as Treatment Provider (TP) under NVHCP.

Sports & Youth Affairs Minister Kento Jini inaugurated the drinking water supply for Kombo Pipak village, near Jirdin in West Siang district, on Tuesday. Jini urged the villagers to spare time and land for overall development of the area. He also informed that "the entire village road connectivity, from SFS College to Tadin, Jelly, Ngomdir, and Beye villages is under construction and there is a plan to construct all-weather road.

Pakke-Kessang Deputy Commissioner Bani Lego flagged off a month-long 'Safai Apnao, Bimari Bhagao' campaign yesterday organised by the District Urban Development Agency. The objective

of the campaign is to promote cleanliness and prevent diseases a critical Endeavour during the monsoon season. The drive will be carried out as per the prepared action plan by various departments till 31 August.
