Minister of State for Personnel, Public Grievances and Pensions Dr Jitendra Singh yesterday launched a special campaign for effective redressal of family pensioners grievances in New Delhi. The Department of Pension and Pensioners' Welfare as part of its 100 Days Action Plan has undertaken a month-long special campaign for effective redressal of Family Pensioners' Grievances from today till the 31st of July in which 46 Ministries and Departments will be participating. This Special campaign seeks a substantial reduction in the pendency of family pension grievances.



The Government has sought suggestions and response from students and parents to develop robust mechanisms in the National Testing Agency-NTA. Nagaland Police have taken different initiative regarding the implementation of New Criminal Laws on 1 of July 2024.
