Three more people, including the main accused in the Hathras stampede case, which claimed 121 lives after Satsang, have been arrested by the police. Hathras Police conducted a medical check-up of the main accused Devprakash Madhukar, arrested from Delhi and after that produced him in court yesterday. The key accused was sent to 14day judicial custody by a magistrate court. Six accused have already been arrested in this case. Speaking to the media, Superintendent of Police (SP) Hathras, Nipun Agarwal, said that the chief organiser and the main accused, Dev Prakash Madhukar was arrested by the Special Operations Group of Hathras police from Najafgarh in Delhi on Friday. The SP said that preliminary interrogation of the main accused has revealed that he has been associated with the organisation for the last several years and was primarily responsible for organising programmes and collecting funds. Police said further investigation is being done in this case while an investigation is also being done regarding the funding of such a big program.
