President Droupadi Murmu held bilateral talks with Prime Minister Christopher Luxon and Deputy Prime Minister and Foreign Affairs Minister Vinston Peters at Government House in Wellington today. Discussions were held on wide range issues including customs co-operation, traditional medicine and renewable energy. India and New Zealand inked the bilateral customs cooperation arrangement which is expected to ease trade between the two countries. Both the countries also agreed to exchange the best practices in the field of traditional medicine through the Global Centre for traditional medicine in Jamnagar.
