PM Modi is the first Indian Prime Minister has landed in Poland today. Morarji Desai was the last Indian Prime Minister to visit Poland in 1979. India and Poland are celebrating the 70th anniversary of diplomatic relations. In a departure statement, Prime Minister Narendra Modi said that Poland is a key economic partner in Central Europe. He said, India and Poland mutual commitment to democracy and pluralism further reinforces relationship between the two nations. The Prime Minister said he will be visiting Ukraine at the invitation of President Volodymyr Zelenskyy and this is the first-ever visit by an Indian Prime Minister to Ukraine. He said he is looking forward to the opportunity to build upon earlier conversations with President Zelenskyy on strengthening bilateral cooperation and share perspectives on peaceful resolution of the ongoing Ukraine conflict. He expressed hope for an early return of peace and stability in the region.

All the four criminals who escaped from the judicial jail in Namsai district have been re-arrested. Arjun Kanda and Robin Surin were arrested on Monday from Piyong Kachari area while Mineswar Dihingia was arrested in the early hours of Tuesday from Boghamur, all within Namsai district. The fourth one, Gopal Munda was hiding till this morning, but around 2:30 am this morning Munda was also arrested from his hideout at Namsai, said Namsai SP Sangey Thinley. All the four jail-breakers did not resist during their re-arrest, the SOP said. He also said that Mineswer Dihingia was hiding in a paddy storage room despite knowing that the police were raiding his house. He was made to surrender at gunpoint. The SP also said that during their escape from the jail, the four criminals got separated and entered uninhabited jungle areas and then fled in different directions.

The Supreme Court has ordered immediate removal from all social media platforms of any references to the name, photos and video clips of Kolkata rape and murder victim. A bench led by Chief Justice of India, DY Chandrachud, gave the directions while hearing the case regarding the alleged rape and murder of a doctor in Kolkata's RG Kar Medical college and Hospital.

Governor of Arunachal Pradesh KT Parnaik participated in the 'One Day State Level Workshop on Model Guidelines with respect to Support Persons as per Section 39 of POCSO Act, 2012 in Arunachal Pradesh' in Itanagar today. The Governor, while expressing his pain about recent POCSO cases in the state, said that it is the obligatory duty of all the people of the State to prevent sexual offences being perpetrated on children in the State. The Governor suggested that the stakeholders must raise awareness amongst parents, teachers and community leaders, tackle root cause of child exploitation, ensure that every child has access to safe spaces, and foster a culture of zero tolerance towards any form of violence against children.

PHE & Water Supply minister Mama Natung on Tuesday met union Jal Shakti minister CR Patil at his office in New Delhi and urged him to release the pending Central government share of 457.59 Cr rupees under JJM. Natung also urged the union minister to consider providing 60.79 Cr rupees under the 'Support Activity & Water Quality Monitoring & Surveillance' component as envisaged in the guidelines. Meanwhile, the union minister assured Natung to release the pending amount and the additional 60.79 cr rupees as sought within two months. During the visit, Natung was accompanied by Seppa East MLA Ealing Tallang, state PHE & WS commissioner Pawan Kr Sain.

Raksha Mantri Rajnath Singh will be on a four-day visit to the US from 23rd August. During the visit, Singh will hold a bilateral meeting with his US counterpart, Secretary Austin. The Defence Ministry said the visit comes in the backdrop of the growing momentum in India-US relations and defense engagements at multiple levels. The visit is expected to further deepen and broaden the India-US Comprehensive Global Strategic Partnership. Singh will chair a high-level roundtable meeting with the US defense industry on the ongoing and future defense collaborations.

The academic board of Adi Ba:né Kébang on Tuesday organized its Annual Excellence Award -2024 function to honour the community achievers in different fields, including toppers of board examinations in Pasighat. Padma Shri awardee Yanung Jamoh Lego and Sangeet Natak Akademi awardee Olen Megu Damin were among the 61-plus achievers who were honoured on the occasion.
