India will host the 3rd Voice of Global South Summit tomorrow in a virtual format. The inaugural session will be at the Head of State and Government level and will be hosted by Prime Minister Narendra Modi. The theme of the Summit is "An Empowered Global South for a Sustainable Future." Briefing reporters in New Delhi, External Affairs Ministry Spokesperson Randhir Jaiswal said that all Global South countries have been invited to attend the summit. The Summit will serve as a platform to expand discussions held in previous summits on a range of complex challenges that continue to affect the world, such as conflicts, food and energy security crises, and climate change. At the Summit, the countries of the Global South will continue deliberations on challenges, priorities, and solutions for the Global South, particularly in the developmental domain.

Union Health Ministry has directed the Head of Institution will be responsible for filing an Institutional FIR within a maximum of six hours in case of violence against Doctors. Director General of Health Services Atul Goel has written a letter to the head of the central government hospitals and medical colleges in this regard. The direction came in the wake of the recent incident of murder of a doctor in Kolkata and protest by the resident doctors over the issue. In his letter he said that recently it has been observed that violence has become common against doctors and other healthcare staff in Government Hospitals. A number of Health workers suffer physical violence during the course of their duty. Many are threatened or exposed to verbal aggression. Most of this violence is done by either patient or patient's attendants.
