Prime Minister Narendra Modi has expressed grief over the loss of lives due to a road mishap in the Tanahun district of Nepal. Mr. Modi in a social media post said that the Indian Embassy is providing all possible assistance to those affected. He expressed his condolences to the bereaved families and wished the injured to recover at the earliest. Meanwhile, PM Modi today has announced ex-gratia of 2 lakh rupees for the next of kin of each deceased and 50,000 rupees for the injured from the Prime Minister's National Relief Fund. The Indian Embassy in Kathmandu said that 27 Indians lost their lives in the accident.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has wrapped up his historic visit to Ukraine today. Mr Modi in a social media post said that he came to this great nation with the aim of deepening India-Ukraine friendship. During the bilateral talks with Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy, PM Modi emphasized the need for Ukraine and Russia to engage in direct negotiations to find a peaceful solution, reaffirming India's consistent support for peace since the conflict began in February 2022. Meanwhile, Ukrainian President Volodymyr Zelenskyy said that India can be a key influence in the global diplomatic efforts to end the war between his country and Russia and also proposed India as a possible host for the second Ukraine peace summit, following the first held in Switzerland in June. Further, Mr Modi also reaffirmed India's commitment to peace and respect for national sovereignty and territorial integrity and later thanked Ukraine's government and people for their warm hospitality.

In major development in R G Kar Medical College rape and murder case Kolkata, the Central Bureau of Investigation (CBI) is conducting polygraph tests on seven individuals, including former R G Kar Medical College Principal Sandip Ghosh and two Kolkata Police civic volunteers including Sanjay Rai, who is currently in jail. Four doctors who were with the victim are also undergoing tests. The necessary approval for the polygraph test was given to CBI by the Sealdah Court. Sanjay Rai was given 14 days jail custody yesterday by the same Court. Additionally, the Special Investigation Team

(SIT) has handed over crucial documents to the CBI, following a directive from the Calcutta High Court.

The Union Ministry of Health and Family Welfare has directed central government hospitals and medical institutes to adopt new dress codes for convocation ceremonies. In a letter to all the Heads of the Central Government Hospitals and Medical Teaching Institutes, the Ministry highlighted the need to move away from colonial traditions like black robes and caps, which originated in Europe. Instead, the Ministry urged institutions to design convocation attire that reflects India's cultural heritage, based on local traditions of each state.

India's first reusable hybrid rocket, Rhumi-1, was launched today from Chennai by Space Zone India in collaboration with Martin Group. The rocket, carrying 50 pico satellites and three cube satellites, reached an altitude of 35 km before returning to Earth. Dr. M Annadurai, former Director of ISRO Space Centre, informed that the rocket used a mix of liquid and solid fuel to enhance efficiency and reduce costs.

Youth Affairs and Sports Minister Dr. Mansukh Mandaviya today has called for nationwide sports participation to mark National Sports Day on 29th August. He emphasized Prime Minister Narendra Modi's vision of a fit India, urging everyone to stay active and maintain their health. Dr. Mandaviya highlighted that National Sports Day is not only to honor sports heroes but also to remind us of the importance of sports in leading a healthy and balanced life.

MLA Nabam Vivek of Doimukh inaugurated a new parking shed and handed over an ambulance to the Health and Wellness Center in Sopo under the Rose Panchayat segment yesterday. The ambulance, donated by NEEPCO's Pare Hydro Project as part of its CSR (Corporate Social responsibility) initiative, aims to enhance emergency response in the area.
