Prime Minister Narendra Modi on Wednesday arrived in Poland and was welcomed with special warmth and exuberance by the Indian community. While speaking to the Indian community in Warsaw, Prime Minister Modi affirmed India's dedication to regional peace and said that India believes in resolving conflicts with diplomacy and dialogue. The Prime Minister reiterated his stance that 'this is not an era of war' and called for unity in tackling humanity's greatest challenges. He highlighted India's humanitarian efforts and praised the Indian community's contributions globally. PM Modi also visited and laid a wreath at Jam Saheb of Nawanagar Memorial in Warsaw.

India and Poland have decided to transform their relationship into a Strategic Partnership. Prime Minister Narendra Modi announced this in the press statement after the delegation level talks with his Polish counterpart Donald Tusk in Warsaw today. He said that this year both nations are celebrating the 70th anniversary of diplomatic relations. He said, India-Poland relations are based on shared values such as democracy and rule of law. Modi said, today is a day of special significance in the relations between India and Poland as after forty-five years an Indian Prime Minister visited Poland. He said, Prime Minister Tusk has been a friend of India for a long time and made huge contributions in enhancing the relationship between India and Poland.

The Ministry of Electronics and Information Technology has asked the social media platforms operating in India to comply with a recent Supreme Court order related to the identity of the deceased in the RG Kar Medical College incident. Earlier, the Supreme Court in its order had directed that all references to the name of the deceased, along with photographs and video clips depicting the deceased, be promptly removed from all social media platforms and electronic media. In light of this order, the Ministry urged all social media companies to ensure that such sensitive information is not further disseminated. It said that failure to comply with the Supreme Court's order may result in legal consequences and further regulatory action.

The Supreme Court continues to grill the West Bengal police and questioned the sequence, timing of legal formalities conducted by police in registration of unnatural death, post-mortem in the hearing of RG Kar Hospital Doctor's rape and Murder case today. The Supreme Court, taking suo motu cognizance of the Kolkata rape-murder case, had asked the CBI to submit a status report on its investigation and CBI has submitted its report today. Kolkata Police also submitted the post-mortem report in the Supreme Court. The SC bench, hearing the case, asked the protesting doctors to resume normal work, saying that justice and medicine cannot afford to be stopped. Subsequently, in the interest of the nation and in the spirit of public service, the Resident Doctors Association, AIIMS, New Delhi, has decided to call off its 11-day strike. The next hearing is on 5th September.

The first National Space Day 2024 will be celebrated across the country tomorrow. On this day last year, Chandrayaan-3 mission accomplished the safe and soft landing of Vikram Lander on the lunar surface. President Droupadi Murmu will inaugurate the main function to be held at Bharat Mandapam in New Delhi. Addressing a curtain raiser press conference in New Delhi on Wednesday, Minister of State for Space Dr Jitendra Singh said, this is the first National Space Day to be observed and it is not only a day of celebration but also a day of reflection, introspection and charting for the future. He said, the space economy will grow five times in the next ten years to around 44 billion dollars.

Banderdewa police in collaboration with Assam police busted a fake eILP racket and three individuals have been arrested in this connection. Acting on a complaint, a joint operation was carried out by Banderdewa police in collaboration with Assam police that led to the arrest of a cybercafe owner at Deejoo, Lakhimpur district, identified as Diluwar Hussain. A computer and other incriminating materials were also seized from the possession of the accused. Later, the police also arrested Ajibur Rehman and Sultan Saddik from Lakhimpur in connection with the fake eILP racket.

Two make-shift poacher camps in Namdapha National Park & Tiger Reserve were dismantled during a combing operation conducted by a team led by field director VK Jawal on Tuesday. The park authority said that Namdapha National Park & Tiger Reserve is a protected area and that any kind of illegal and unlawful activity in

and around the park will not be tolerated. The team included range forest officers and the members of Special Tiger Protection Force.

President Droupadi Murmu today conferred Rashtriya Vigyan Puraskar 2024 to renowned and distinguished scientists at Rashtrapati Bhavan. Prof Govindarajan Padmanabhan was given the Vigyan Ratna 2024 award by the President. Dr. Anandharamakrishnan received Vigyan Shri award in the field of Agricultural Science. Dr. Avesh Kumar Tyagi from Bhabha Atomic Research Centre, Mumbai was conferred upon Vigyan Shri award in the field of Atomic Energy. Prof. Jayant Bhalchandra Udgaonkar from Indian Institute of Science Education and Research, Pune was awarded Vigyan Shri award in Biological Sciences.
