The Rajya Sabha yesterday took up discussion on the workings of the Ministry of Agriculture and Farmers Welfare. Initiating the discussion, Randeep Singh Surjewala of Congress criticised the government for not being able to fulfill the promise of doubling farmers' income by 2022. He alleged that the income of farmers has rather come down in some states. Surjewala also said the allocation for agriculture in the budget has come down. He demanded a legal guarantee of MSP to farmers. Phangnon Konyak of the BJP said the Agriculture Ministry's efforts are essential for fostering a productive, sustainable, and equitable agricultural system. She said increasing the income of farmers has been one of the key priorities of the Narendra Modi government. V Vijayasai Reddy of YSRCP expressed concern that agricultural lands are being converted to non-agricultural use.



Deputy Commissioner and Chairman District Disaster Management Authority, DDMA Niuland, Sara S. Jamir, held an emergency meeting with the DDMA members at DC's office, Nuiland yesterday.
