Mokokchung police said that one person identified as 33 year old Moakaba Aier who is an 'SS' Sergeant in NSCN (Khango) has been arrested in connection with a case of sexual assault of a three year old at Saring village under Mokokchung district. Additional SO and PRO Mokokchung police in a press release yesterday said that the arrest was made after an FIR was received on August 11. Police said that a criminal case has been registered against the accused at Women Police Station Mokokchung. The release further added that the accused is presently under police custody and the case is under investigation.

The Nagaland Legislative Assembly Speaker and Chairman of the House Committee has convened a meeting of the House Committee on 19th August 2024. The Speaker has informed all concerned Committee Members to meet at 11 AM in the Committee Room of the Assembly Secretariat.

The department of Power, Nagaland has informed that power supply to Phek district and Meluri area have been affected due to line fault in the 132 KV Meluri-Kiphire transmission line since August 12. Executive Engineer, Transmission Division Kohima in a release said that 132 KV Kohima-Meluri-Kiphire transmission line was damaged by landslide due to 2-laning road earth cutting works by NHIDCL near Losami village, Phek district during September 2023 and is yet to be restored. The power supply to Kiphire and Phek districts including LHEP is being fed temporarily through 66 kV Tuensang-Kiphire Transmission Line. The department said it is making all efforts to restore the 132 KV Meluri-Kiphire transmission line at the earliest and appealed to the consumers to bear with the inconvenience caused.
