The Bharatiya Vayuyan Vidheyak 2024 was introduced in the Lok Sabha yesterday by the Union Civil Aviation Minister Kinjarapu Rammohan Naidu. While introducing the Bill, the Minister said, Aircraft Act was brought in 1934 and a lot of amendments have been made over the years. He said these amendments created a lot of ambiguity and contradictions in terms of the functioning of internal organisations like the Directorate General of Civil Aviation and the Bureau of Civil Aviation Security. He said The Bharatiya Vayuyan Vidheyak has been brought to clear out the confusion. The Bill empowers the Central Government to make rules for any aircraft or class of aircraft, and for securing the safety of aircraft operations. It is aimed to empower the government to make rules for the investigation of any air accident or incident.

The Har Ghar Tiranga campaign will be celebrated across the country from the 9th to the 15th of August to bolster a sense of patriotism among citizens. Addressing a press conference in New Delhi yesterday, Culture and Tourism Minister Gajendra Singh Shekhawat urged people to hoist the Tiranga at their homes take a selfie with the Tiranga and upload it on the Har Ghar Tiranga website. He said the Har Ghar Tiranga campaign was started in 2022 under the aegis of Azadi Ka Amrit Mahotsav. Shekhawat said last year more than ten crore people uploaded their selfies with Tiranga. He added that more than two hundred cultural programmes will be organised across the country. The Minister said the Tiranga Bike Rally with Members **Parliament** and the Minister will be organised on 13th August.

Nobel laureate Muhammad Yunus has been sworn-in as the head of Bangladesh's interim government. Bangladesh President Mohammed Shahabuddin administered the oath to him at Bangabhaban in Dhaka. Diplomats from various countries were present on the occassion. Born on 28 June 1940, Muhammad Yunus is a Bangladeshi entrepreneur, banker, and economist. He was awarded the Nobel

Peace Prize in 2006 for founding the Grameen Bank and pioneering the concepts of microcredit and microfinance.

The Reserve Bank of India decided to keep the policy rate unchanged for the ninth time in a row. The rate increase cycle was paused in April last year after six consecutive rate hikes, aggregating to 250 basis points since May 2022. Announcing the third bi-monthly monetary policy for the current financial year, RBI Governor Shaktikanta Das said the Monetary Policy Committee has decided to keep the reporate unchanged at 6.5 per cent. Consequently, the Standing Deposit Facility rate remains at 6.25 percent and the Marginal Standing Facility rate and the Bank Rate at 6.75 per cent.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi is scheduled to visit the landslide ravaged Wayanad on Saturday. Preparations are underway in Kannur and Wayanad for the visit. Security meetings were held in Kannur and Wayanad ahead of the visit. The Prime Minister is likely to conduct an aerial survey of the landslide affected area of Wayanad.

At the 2024 Paris Olympics, India's star track and field athlete Neeraj Chopra recorded his season-best throw of 89.45 meters to win a silver medal in the men's javelin last night. Pakistan's Arshad Nadeem shattered the all-time Olympic record of 90.57 meters with a throw of 92.97 meters to clinch the gold medal. Prime Minister Narendra Modi and President Droupadi Murmu and Home Minister congratulated Neeraj Chopra for winning the silver medal at the Paris Olympics. Meanwhile, the Indian Hockey team bagged the fourth Bronze medal for the country. The team defeated Spain 2-1 in the bronze medal match. The team also gave its goalkeeper Sreejesh the perfect farewell by securing this Olympic medal. President and Prime Minister haa d also congratulated the Indian Hockey team for for securing the Bronze Medal.

Nagaland Junior Girls U-17 defeated Sainik School 5-1 in the last league match of the ongoing 63rd edition of U-17 Subroto Cup 2024 at New Delhi yesterday. However the team narrowly missed out on a quarter-final berth due to goal difference. During the match, Mhalo scored four goals and Akhrienuo added another

one during the match. With this, Nagaland team finished in second position of the Pool G group with 7 points which was topped by NCC Mizoram with 7 points. Team Manager for Nagaland U-17 Girls Football team, William Koso expressed his appreciation of the team's performance at the tournament and stated that it was a very good exposure and experience for the team.
