India has carried out a successful launch of an Intermediate Range Ballistic Missile, Agni-4, from the Integrated Test Range at Chandipur in Odisha. The Defence Ministry said the launch successfully validated all operational and technical parameters. It was conducted under the aegis of the Strategic Forces Command. The launch marks another milestone in strengthening India's defence capabilities. In April this year, India successfully tested the new-generation nuclear-capable Agni-Prime ballistic missile from the Abdul Kalam Island off the coast of Odisha. Strategic Forces Command (SFC), along with the Defence Research and Development Organisation (DRDO), had conducted the successful flight test. The Agni missiles are long-range, nuclear weapon-capable surface-to-surface ballistic missiles developed by India.

Prime Minister Narendra Modi has said that teachers are rendering a very important service to the nation, and the responsibility of preparing today's youth for Viksit Bharat rests in their hands. Interacting with teachers who were conferred with the National Teachers Awards in New Delhi at his residence yesterday, Modi emphasised that we all should make efforts to prepare capable citizens and youth for Viksit Bharat. Senior BJP leader and Union Home Minister Amit Shah today assured the restoration of statehood to Jammu and Kashmir after the assembly polls. Addressing a public meeting in Jammu, he said the coming assembly elections in J&K are historic as it is taking place for the first time under the national flag and the Constitution following the abrogation of Article 370 by the Modi government. The Home Minister is in Jammu, on a two-day visit, to boost the BJP's election campaign for the three-phase assembly elections, beginning September 18.

The "Tomo Riba Institute of Health and Medical Sciences" (TRIHMS) is gearing up to launch the 2nd phase of the National Mental Health Survey (NMHS-2) to tackle mental health challenges in Arunachal Pradesh. To be conducted in collaboration with the

National Institute of Mental Health and Neurosciences (NIMHANS), the survey will examine mental health issues, including anxiety, mood disorders, substance abuse, and emerging concerns like internet and gaming addiction. The survey will provide critical data on mental health across different age groups and vulnerable populations. The survey will initially cover five districts - Papum Pare, Tawang, West Siang, Lohit, and Longding.

Chief Minister Pema Khandu called on the Tibetan spiritual leader, Dalai Lama, at his residence in Dharamshala on Friday and extended an invitation for the Nobel laureate to visit Arunachal Pradesh. Khandu said in a social media post that the Dalai Lama graciously accepted the invite, saying he would visit whenever he feels the call. Khandu also presented a framed photo of the 'Phodrang' to the Dalai Lama. The Phodrang or the sacred residence built at Pungteng in Tawang, where he spent a few cherished days after his escape from Tibet in 1959.

The festival of Ganesh Chaturthi is being celebrated today across the country with great devotion. The day marks the birth of Lord Ganesha, who is a symbol of wisdom, prosperity, and good fortune. Ganesh Chaturthi is a major attraction in Maharashtra, where people celebrate it with great zeal. Meanwhile, President Droupadi Murmu and Prime Minister Narendra Modi greeted the people on the auspicious occasion of Ganesh Chaturthi.

The inauguration of the state-of-the-art school hostel and classroom in the vibrant village of Arunachal Pradesh has sent waves of excitement throughout the community. Papikrung School, located close to the international border, is being managed by the village locals with the support of "Sun Bird Trust Foundation" and Indian Army. The school currently has over 100 students.
