The Armed Forces (Special Powers) Act, AFSPA, has been been extended in eight districts of Nagaland and a few areas in five districts for six months, effective from 1st October. According to a notification from the Home Ministry, these districts are Dimapur, Niuland, Chumoukedima, Mon, Kiphire, Noklak, Phek, and Peren. AFSPA has also been extended in three districts of Arunachal Pradesh and a few areas in Namsai district for six months. The districts are Tirap, Changlang, and Longding.

Narcotics and Psychotropic Substances seized by the Narcotics Cell were destroyed at Kohima Municipal Council dumping site Meriema in Kohima. The destruction was carried out by the Drug Disposal Committee, under the Inspector General of Police (CID), Police Headquarter Kohima. The total items seized during 2022- 2023 included 500 soap cases of Heroin, 44 packets of Opium and 25 packets of Yaba Tablet worth over 44 crore rupees. The seized items were destroyed in the presence of officials from the Police, District Court, Kohima Municipal Council and Kripa Foundation among others.

The central government has announced an increase in minimum wage rates by revising the Variable Dearness Allowance. The new wage rates will take effect from the 1st of next month. The revised wages are intended to help workers, particularly those in the unorganized sector. The minimum wage rates are categorized based on skill levels, as well as by geographical areas A, B, and C. After the revision, minimum wage rates for workers in area 'A' in construction, sweeping, cleaning, and loading and unloading for unskilled work will be 783 rupees a day. For semi-skilled workers, the minimum wage will be 868 rupees a day, and for skilled, clerical, the minimum wage will be 954 rupees a day. For highly skilled workers, the revised wage will be 1,035 rupees a day.
