Prime Minister Narendra Modi will hold talks with Brunei's Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah today. The discussions are likely to touch upon on all aspects of bilateral relations and also explore new areas of cooperation. Several MoUs are expected to be exchanged following the talk. Modi reached Bandar Seri Begawan yesterday on the first leg of his two-nation tour to Brunei and Singapore. This is the first-ever bilateral visit by an Indian Prime Minister to Brunei. The visit coincides with the 40th anniversary of the establishment of diplomatic ties between India and Brunei. Yesterday, Prime Minister Modi inaugurated the new Chancery of the High Commission of India, in Bandar Seri Begawan. He also visited the Omar Ali Saifuddien Mosque in Brunei. Prime Minister Modi will head for Singapore later today.

President Droupadi Murmu has asserted the country's progress cannot be fully realised without women's socio-economic and educational development. Speaking at the centenary celebrations of the Maharashtra Legislative Council in Mumbai yesterday, the President emphasised the need to change the way women are viewed. She pointed out that women constitute half of India's population, and added that their active participation in various spheres was needed to take the country forward.



The government has given approval to proposals worth one lakh 45 thousand crore rupees to enhance the country's defence preparedness. The Defence Acquisition Council under the chairmanship of Defence Minister Rajnath Singh approved 10 capital acquisition proposals. The Council gave a nod to procurement of Future Ready Combat Vehicles, Air Defence Fire Control Radars, Dornier-228 aircraft, Next Generation Fast Patrol and Offshore Patrol Vessels.



A 16-day training programme for Heads of Offices(HoOs) and Drawing & Disbursal Officers (DDOs) on service matters commenced yesterday at the Administration Training Institution, Kohima. Commissioner & Secretary, P & AR, Anoop Khinchi, called upon HoOs and DDOs to be well equipped with all the latest rules and guidelines of the service matters to ensure overall operation and worker-employee relationship. Director, ATI & Secretary P&AR, Akunu S. The 13th Assam Rifles is conducting a small arms firing exercise at the Firing Range, Kohima Garrison till 30th of September. In this regard, Deputy Commissioner, Kohima, Kumar Ramnikant has advised all residents of concerned villages, Ward Panchayats, and Colonies under Kohima Town to strictly avoid entering the Firing Range area during this period. Further, cattle grazing near the Firing area are also prohibited during the exercise.
