Prime Minister Narendra Modi yesterday gave the PUSHP mantra for making India a developed nation. India has signed the first-of-its-kind agreements focused on a Clean Economy, Fair Economy, and the overarching Indo-Pacific Economic Framework, IPEF in Delaware, USA. These agreements were exchanged under the IPEF for prosperity on Saturday in the presence of Prime Minister Narendra Modi, who is on a three-day visit to the US for the Quad Summit. The Agreement on Clean Economy intends to promote technical cooperation, workforce development, capacity building, and research collaborations. It will facilitate investments and project financing, including concessional financing, as well as joint collaborative projects, with a particular emphasis on supporting Micro, Small, and Medium Enterprises. The Fair Economy Agreement seeks to create more transparent and predictable trade and investment environment across the Indo-Pacific. The IPEF Agreement aims to establish high-level political oversight framework at the ministerial level for the various individual IPEF agreements, providing general guidance and goals

Union Minister of Commerce and Industry Piyush Goyal will visit Australia from today to participate in the 19th India-Australia Joint Ministerial Commission meeting. Goyal will co-chair the meeting with Minister of Trade and Tourism of Australia Don Farrell on Wednesday. During the meeting, both countries will discuss ways to elevate bilateral economic engagement. The Commerce and Industry Ministry said the visit will add further impetus to the strong and growing trade and investment ties between India and Australia, which have received a boost following the finalisation of the bilateral Economic Cooperation and Trade Agreement. It will encourage business-to-business engagement and promote strategic partnerships across sectors of priority to both sides, including critical minerals, manufacturing, education, renewable energy, infrastructure, tourism, and space.

India has struck historic double gold medals in the 2024 Chess Olympiad in Budapest, Hungary. Both men and women teams emerged on top. In the open section, India's maiden title win was secured following Arjun Erigaisi's victory over Jan Subelj of Slovenia in the final round of the competition. Second-placed China dropped crucial points against the USA in their fixture, and India clinched the title. The Indian team for the open category included Gukesh D, Praggnanandhaa R, Arjun Erigaisi, Vidit Gujrathi, Pentala Harikrishna, and Srinath Narayanan. In the open section, India's best performances prior to this year have been the bronze medals in 2022 and 2014. In the women's section final, the Indian women's team defeated Azerbaijan 3.5-0.5 to clinch the gold. The team comprised Harika Dronavalli, Vaishali Rameshbabu, Divya Deshmukh, Vantika Agrawal and Tania Sachdev.
