Nagaland Power Department has informed that some technical fault developed in the 66/33KV, 10 MVA Power Transformer on Friday at 66/33KV, Tuensang Sub-station under transmission Division Mokokchung. In this, the department said that power supply to Tuensang, Noklak and Shamator districts has been disrupted, while it is making all possible arrangements to rectify the problem. In this regard, the department has informed that an emergency arrangement has been put in place to supply power to the affected areas from the existing 5 MVA transformer for which there will be imposition of frequent load restrictions till the 10 MVA Power Transformer is fully restored and charged. Therefore, the department has urged the consumers to bear with the inconveniences as the department is making best efforts in resolving the issue at the earliest.

In sports, Indian shooter Rubina Francis won bronze in the women's 10 meter air pistol SH1 final qualification round in the Paralympic Games, yesterday. Rubina secured India's fourth medal in shooting at the 17th Summer Paralympic Games. The 25-year-old shooter from Madhya Pradesh scored a total of 211.1 to finish third in the final. A total of five Wushu fighters were selected by the Nagaland Wushu Association, NWA to represent the state at the upcoming 33rd Senior National Wushu Championship to be held in Dehradun, Uttarakhand, from 21st to 26th September. The selection trial was held in Sovima Village, Chümoukedima district yesterday. The players representing the state are Vipu Zhimomi in the 52 kg category, Mankho T. Konyak in the 56 kg category, Nupa Kiho in the 60 kg category, Lichonthung Odyuo in the 65 kg category, and Yoto Chizo in the 70 kg category. The team will be led by Neizouvotuo Khusoh as the team coach, R.K. Shanti Kumar Singh as the assistant coach, and Azhove Resu as the team manager of the state team.
