Prime Minister Narendra Modi will embark on a three-day visit to Brunei and Singapore today. The Prime Minister is visiting Brunei at the invitation of Sultan Haji Hassanal Bolkiah. This will be the first-ever bilateral visit by an Indian Prime Minister to Brunei. On the second leg of his tour, the Prime Minister will visit Singapore on the 4th and 5th of September.

The Cabinet Committee on Security has approved the proposal for the procurement of 240 aero-engines for the Su-30 MKI aircraft of the Indian Air Force. The approval was granted under the Buy (Indian) category from Hindustan Aeronautics Limited (HAL) at a cost of over 26,000 crore rupees, inclusive of all taxes and duties. The Ministry of Defence said that the delivery of these aero-engines would begin after one year and be completed over a period of eight years.

The Central Bureau of Investigation arrested the former Principal of Kolkata's RG Kar Medical College and Hospital, Dr Sandip Ghosh yesterday over 'financial misconduct' in the medical establishment. He was being interrogated by the agency in connection with the rape and murder of a woman doctor, as well as financial irregularities at the hospital.

The Nagaland Board of School Education, NBSE said all the schools offering Financial Literacy course in Class IX & X will conduct the Financial Literacy Examination 2024 through offline mode only on 20th September from 10:00 am to 12:00 pm. The Question Paper and necessary examination materials will be provided by the Board. For Kohima district, schools should collect the examination materials on 18th of this month from the Board's Office during Office hours. For other districts, the Question Paper and examination materials will be delivered

by the Board to the designated schools whereby the schools should collect the materials on 18th September. The question paper will consist of 100 Multiple Choice Questions carrying one mark each. Only those students who are registered and have paid the course fee to the Board are eligible to sit for the examination.



Deputy Chief Minister Y Patton has greeted the Sangtams on the occasion of Mungmung festival. Patton said that the celebrations lasting for six days pays tribute to the Creator, by colorful display of the rich cultural traditions. On behalf of the state BJP legislators, the Deputy Chief Minister conveyed heartiest festive greetings and hope that it is celebrated in the spirit of Mungmung, which is 'togetherness forever'.



The national portal for unorganised workers, eShram has achieved over 30 crore registrations in the last 3 years. The Ministry of Labour and Employment said that since its launch in 2021, the portal has showcased a rapid and widespread adoption among the unorganised workers. The Ministry said that it is coordinating with different Ministries and Departments to develop eShram as "One-Stop-Solution" for Unorganised Workers.



The Investor Education and Protection Fund Authority (IEPFA) has launched a new five-digit toll-free number, 1-4-4-5-3, as part of its ongoing efforts to enhance claimant support services. The new toll-free number will provide users with access to an upgraded, multi-language Interactive Voice Response System (IVRS) and an enhanced call center. The Ministry of Corporate Affairs said that the IVRS will be available 24/7 to ensure that assistance is always accessible, while the Call Centre will operate from 9:30 AM to 5:30 PM every weekday during business hours. Meanwhile, the old toll-free number is discontinued as part of the update.



The Razeba Public Organisation in collaboration with the three village Chairman organised the mass social work yesterday. The Razeba Area comprises of three village -Zhavame(Vegetable village), Tsupfume
