MANIPUR:

In Manipur, the students' protest escalated at different valley areas and the State Government imposed indefinite curfew in three valley districts and shut down internet services till the 15th of this month. In Imphal city, thousands of students took to the road towards Raj Bhavan demanding the Governor to translate their charter of demands. These include removal of Security Advisor and DGP, entrusting the Unified command charge with the Chief Minister and withdrawal of Central forces.

LOTTERY:

ALERT:

Deputy Chief Minister of Nagaland, Y Patton has said the state government is on high alert and will take all steps to prevent any influx of illegal immigrants into the state. Mr Patton who holds the Home portfolio, assured the public that district administrations, police and other state and central agencies were well prepared to

prevent any influx of illegal immigrants. The Deputy Chief Minister called upon the civil society organizations of Nagaland to remain calm and extend full cooperation to the government so as to ensure the security and integrity of the state.

HPC:

The Meghalaya government has scheduled a decisive meeting with the Harijan Panchayat Committee (HPC) in the last week of September, to be chaired by the Chief Secretary. This meeting comes after the HPC requested an extension from the government to provide their final decision on the proposed relocation from Them Iew Mawlong to Bishop Cotton Road in Shillong. Deputy Chief Minister in charge of Urban Affairs, Sniawbhalang Dhar, confirmed the development, stating, the Harijan Panchayat Committee has requested an extension until the last week of September.
