External Affairs Minister Dr S Jaishankar today inaugurated the eMigrate V2.0 web portal and Mobile App in Delhi. The eMigrate portal with its 2.81 lakh registered foreign employers aims to promotes safe and legal mobility channels for Indian migrants. In his address, Dr Jaishankar asserted that the launch of the eMigrate V2.0 portal is a testament to the government's efforts to create safe, transparent and inclusive mobility for Indians. He said the revamped version of the portal is a symbol of the government's commitment to protecting the rights and dignity of Indian workers in foreign lands.

The Reserve Bank of India, Governor Shaktikanta Das today said that India has developed a world-class digital public infrastructure which has facilitated the development of high-quality digital financial products. He further added that the country is now home to the world's third most vibrant startup ecosystem, with over one lakh 40 thousand startups, and more than a hundred unicorns. Addressing an event RBI@90 High-Level Conference in New Delhi, Das stressed that India's experience in digital public infrastructure can be leveraged by other countries to improve and usher in a global digital revolution.

Governor Lt. General K.T. Parnaik (Retd.) has extended his warm greetings to the people of the State, particularly to Sajolang community on the festive occasion of Chindang. He expressed his hope that the festivity will usher in a good harvest, prosperity, and happiness for all.
