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Nagaland Police have cautioned the citizens about online scams targeting WhatsApp users. The Police said, the scammers are reportedly sending malicious links or APK files via WhatsApp or other social media platforms, which, when clicked resulted to WhatsApp account being hacked. It said, Whatsapp is also hacked by sharing of whatsapp verification code to scammers. The state Police said, that the scammer used the hacked accounts to impersonate the victim and ask for financial assistance from their contact list. The Police warned that the consequences of a hacked WhatsApp account extend beyond financial fraud. The authorities therefore advised WhatsApp users to exercise caution when receiving unsolicited messages. They also recommend enabling two-step verification for enhanced security of the whatsapp account. Users are urged to refrain from clicking or installing unknown links or APK files unknown sources. The Police further warned users not to share their WhatsApp verification codes, emphasizing that WhatsApp never ask for such information. Anyone requesting or sharing this code is for scam only. The authorities also said that if such monetary requests are received through whatsapp, the user should always call the person to confirm the authenticity.
